Once the application has been processed by the DNR, the applicant will be considered the Voluntary Party for this property. The Voluntary Party is responsible for payment of any fees to the DNR. Unless the DNR is notified to the contrary, all bills and correspondence as part of the VPLE process will be sent to the Voluntary Party. If more than one party is applying for the VPLE for the same property, each party must submit a separate application form and \$250 fee.

Section 3: Ownership Information - Answer the question regarding the relationship of the Applicant to the property.

Section 4: Regulatory Identification - Provide readily available regulatory identification.
