## Dear Bishop Daniels:

On November 4, 2010, Giles Engineering, in a telephone conversation, notified the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources ("the Department") of a fuel oil discharge to the environment. Deb Roszak (WDNR Enforcement & Science) and I visited the site to document this occurrence (see enclosed photographs). We both observed that fuel oil was floating on top of the groundwater and contaminated soil was stocked piled next to the trenched area. On November 30, 2010, the Department received laboratory documentation that fuel oil sampled from the soil excavated from the trench had a TPH-DRO of 25,000 ppm. This is above the s. NR 720.09(4)(a), Wis. Adm. Code, generic residual contaminant level of 100 ppm.

Based on the observations and laboratory documentation, we believe you are responsible for investigating and restoring the environment at the above-described site under Section 292.11, Wisconsin Statutes, known as the hazardous substances spills law.

This letter describes the legal responsibilities of a person who is responsible under section 292.11, explains what you need to do to investigate and clean up the contamination, and provides you with information about cleanups, environmental consultants, possible financial assistance, and working cooperatively with the WDNR, Department of Commerce ("Commerce") or the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection.

## Legal Responsibilities:

Your legal responsibilities are defined both in statute and in administrative codes. The hazardous substances spill law, Section 292.11 (3) Wisconsin Statutes, states:

• RESPONSIBILITY. A person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is discharged or who causes the discharge of a hazardous substance shall take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable and minimize the harmful effects from the discharge to the air, lands, or waters of the state.

Unless otherwise requested, please send only one copy of plans and reports. In addition to the paper copy, an electronic copy may also be submitted. To speed processing, correspondence should reference the BRRTS and FID numbers (if assigned) shown at the top of this letter.
