Additional Comments : Mike Lueskow of Marinette Marine Corporation (MMC) contacted Cathy Rodda at 2:29 pm on March 17, 2003, at the Peshtigo Service Center. Lueskow advised Rodda that a spill had occurred at the facility the previous day at approximately 6:20 pm as the result of hydraulic oil leaking from a small shack on the MMC property near the river. The spill started on the concrete slab in this area, and was thought to have been cleaned up adequately. The next morning it was discovered that some of the hydraulic oil had been missed and subsequently had settled in a runoff trench by the shack. The oil had then dripped from the trench down onto the ice in the Menominee River. Lueskow estimated that 3 gallons of GT1500 hydraulic oil had been released. MMC's contractor (Jacobis) and consultant (ECCI) were called and responded to clean up the spill. Lueskow further stated that spaghetti pillows and absorbent booms were placed on the spilled product. The spill was also addressed with MX1, a material that bonds to the oil and breaks it down. The Coast Guard was also notified and responded to the spill per Lueskow, and assigned a confirmation number of 639706. Lueskow stated that the proper forms were filled out and that a follow-up report would be submitted to the DNR within 45 days. Rodda advised Lueskow to submit any reports to Roxanne Chronert, the NER Spills Coordinator. Lueskow also advised Rodda that the reason for the leak was avoidable, and the problem has been fixed .

At the request of Rodda, Conservation Warden Shane Fields visited the MMC facility on March 19, 2003. After a site visit, Warden Fields advised Rodda that the spill appeared to have been responded to appropriately by the RP. Warden Fields stated that he asked the RP to add more of the MX1 material to help breakdown the residual oil on the ice; the request was granted and the site appears to have been cleaned up adequately.

I just rec'd a call from Mike Lueskow at Marinette Marine. MMC's spill response group (Jacobis) was called out as was ECCI from Green Bay. Apparently hydraulic oil was released, as you said Roxanne, from a spill on concrete yesterday, into a runoff channel, and then overnight dripping from this channel onto the ice. Spaghetti pillows and booms were placed on the ice and the Coast Guard was notified. They also placed MX1 on the remaining oil to break it down.
