I am writing to request a cost cap for the 1404 S. Webster Ave site, PECFA #54301-2504-04.

Due to having to use two different drilling/geoprobe companies, as well as extra footage and number of samples collected for laboratory analysis, the total cost of the Drilling/Geoprobe project was \$17,376.07. After adding this to the previous costs incurred for this project (workplan, access permission/agreements and waste disposal), the total cost was \$21,258.34.

Therefore, the drilling/geoprobe project put this over the \$20k budget by \$1,258.34.

I am writing to request that these costs, \$1,258.34, be approved prior to submitting the PECFA reimbursement claim.
