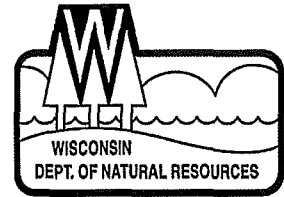

On December 2, 2012, you were notified by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) of your responsibility to investigate and, as needed, clean up contamination located at the above-referenced property. As the responsible party of this property you have certain legal responsibilities to take actions to restore the environment to the extent practicable as outlined in Section 292.11(3), Wisconsin Stats., also known as the hazardous substances spill law.

Our files indicate that the last written correspondence for this case was a "Project Summary" report dated August 15, 2013. The report recommended that the available data be reviewed to determine the next steps for this project. The DNR has since received no further information. In order to get this case back on track towards remediation and, ultimately, closure, have your consultant prepare and submit documentation on the current status and planned actions for this case. Please have this information submitted within 30 days, March 27.
