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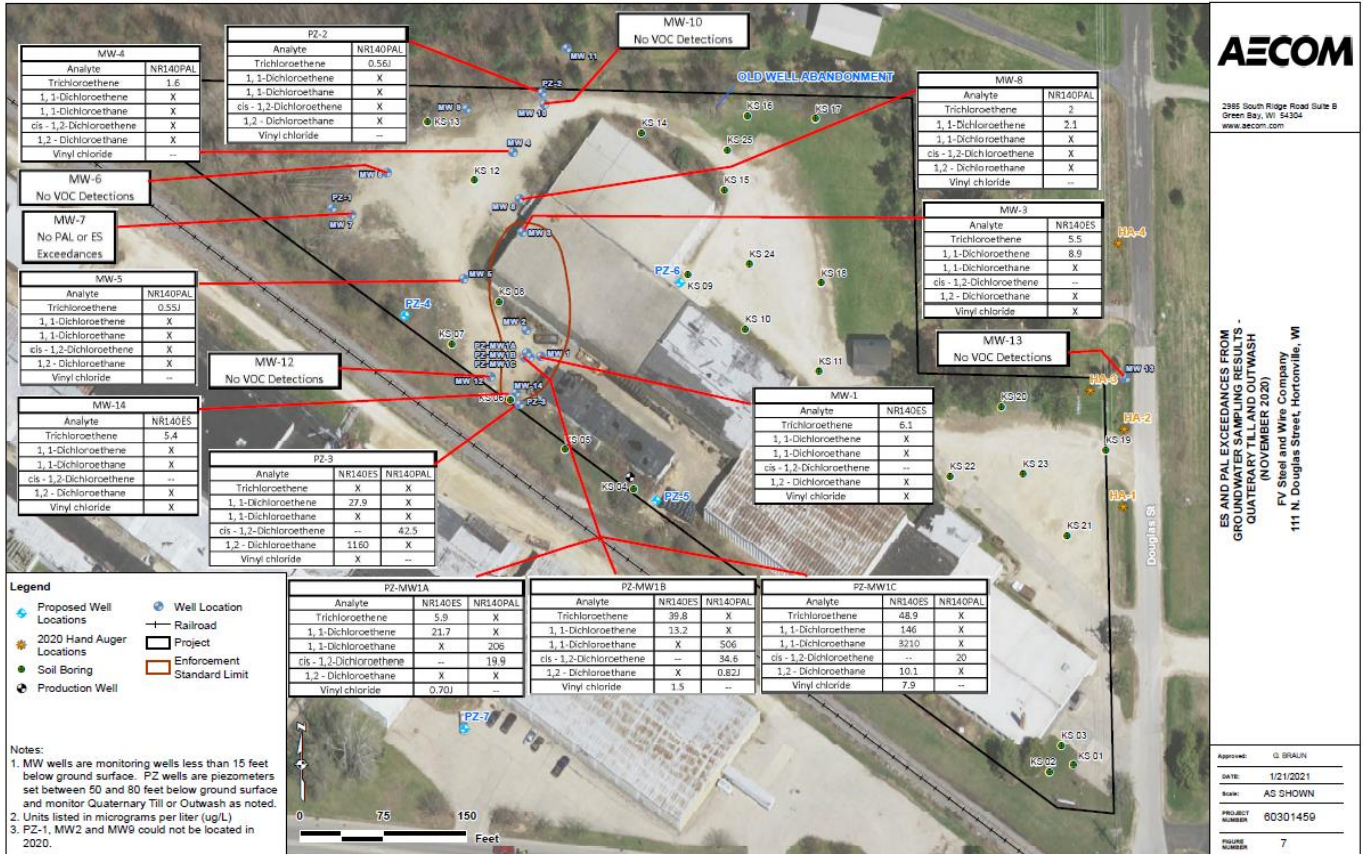

I think this is likely MW-13 based on description and photos. I looked 3-30-2021 and MW-13 appears to be ND for VOCs based on Figure 7.
