Dear Mr. Walia:

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR or the Department) is requesting information regarding activities associated with petroleum contamination at the site referenced above. Our records indicate that you are the owner of this property and that you have not made any recent efforts to fulfill your responsibility to clean up the contamination.

I am writing to remind you that the petroleum storage tank release is eligible for cleanup cost reimbursement from the Petroleum Environmental Cleanup Fund Award (PECFA) program. Changes to the PECFA program have made it easier for property owners like you to move forward and complete cleanups.

Wisconsin's recently signed budget calls for the PECFA program to sunset by 2020. By taking action now to address contamination on your property, you have access to this unique financial reimbursement assistance while it is still available.

By March 26, 2016, please inform DNR in writing of your intentions to bring this case to closure. Be aware that periods of inactivity and non-compliance can affect PECFA eligibility (if applicable). In addition, the Department can pursue enforcement actions if you do not respond to this request for information.
