The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has completed a review of the March 22, 2023, Facility-Wide Groundwater Monitoring Plan Update (Monitoring Plan Update), submitted to the DNR on your behalf by Barr Engineering (Barr). A technical assistance review fee of \$700 was included for the DNR's review and comment on the Monitoring Plan Update.

Based on the groundwater monitoring results from past monitoring and the information in the above-referenced submittal, the DNR approves the proposed change in groundwater monitoring to eliminate the collection of various field parameters, which include temperature, conductivity, dissolved oxygen, and pH.

The DNR may request additional investigation, monitoring, or remedial action if future groundwater monitoring indicates contamination from discharges of hazardous substances at the Enbridge Terminal has migrated to groundwater. If necessary, the DNR will utilize the range of options available in Wisconsin Administrative Code (Wis. Admin. Code) sec. NR 140.24, NR 140.26, the October 2, 2018, Negotiated Agreement between the DNR and Enbridge Energy, and Wis. Admin. Code chs. NR 700-754 to request additional action.
