Disposition of Neutralized Cleanup Materials

Dear Mrs. Nelezen Chronert:

As mentioned during our recent conversations, the small quantity of acetic acid that was released was promptly isolated with Oil Dri then neutralized with excess Bicarbonate of Soda. The resulting "solid" Oil Dri - calcium acetate - sodium bicarbonate mixture was scooped up into one of our "salt buggies" and put into a special waste "Lugger Box" along with other salts from our wastewater pre-treatment process (evaporation/crystallization/centrifugation/distillation/absorption). Full Lugger Boxes at SpecialtyChem are routinely picked up several times weekly by CWM Midwest Transport and taken to the AETS Controlled Waste Division facility, Menomonee Falls, WI for further handling.
