

Beth,

The spill occurred at ~3:00 pm on August 26th. We were pumping oily water from a tank on the ship in the engine room to a double walled oil water tank on the dock. The operator lost track of time and miscalculated to total water in the tank. The tank on the dockwall overflowed. We estimate about 100 gallons spilled out and maybe upwards of 15-25 gallons of oil got into the water. We quickly contained the spill and OSI had a vac truck on site that they used to suck the oil out of the water. That waste goes off site to a treatment facility and the absorbents used go to a waste to energy facility. Let me know if you need any further detail. Thanks
