

Dear Mr. Christner:

On July 16, 2014, ICECOR, on behalf of Steve Christner, Jr., notified the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) that petroleum contamination had been detected at the site listed above.

A release of gasoline from an Underground Petroleum Storage Tank System was noted in the soil, and it is possible that it may be impacting the groundwater. There is a potable well within 250 feet of the facility and it located on the south side of the building. The surface water body with 1000 feet of the facility is Wilkerson Lake which is ~ 0.3 miles southeast of the facility. The depth to groundwater is estimated to be 30-40 feet below ground surface.

This letter is to notify you that the following additional information is required to be submitted to the WDNR before the Department can determine whether or not you should proceed with a site investigation under NR 716, Wis. Adm. Code. The soil sample ID # B-4 (10.5' below the ground surface) with benzene measured at 27.5J ug/kg is the soil sample resulting in the issuance of this letter. The submittal of the following information may allow the Department to conclude that no further action is required at the site described above. Soil samples shall be collected surrounding the area of the contaminated soil sample at equal and lower depths, in addition at least one soil sample shall be collected from the former excavation bottom. In addition, a groundwater grab sample shall be collected from the water table and it should be from the bottom of the former excavation, as well. The compounds to analyze both soil and groundwater for are PVOCs + naphthalene. Please submit this information within 60 days after the date of this letter, so that we can determine whether or not a full site investigation under NR 716, Wis. Adm. Code, will be required.

Sites where discharges to the environment have been reported are entered into the Bureau for Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System (BRRTS), a version of which appears on the WDNR's Internet site. If you submit the additional information described in this letter, and the Department concludes that no further investigation is required, the status of the site described above will be shown as "no action required" on BRRTS. You may view the information related to your site at any time (<u>http://dnr.wi.gov/topic/Brownfields/clean.html</u>) and use the feedback system to alert us to any errors in the data.

If the Department determines that an NR 716 site investigation is not required and you want a written response regarding the "no action required" status, please be advised that under NR 708.09, Wis. Adm. Code, a \$350.00 fee is required for a No Further Action Letter.
