Just a quick update: it all went well. The soil was excavated to 4.5 feet in the main spill area, and to $10^{"}$ where some minor runoff was observed. We did it Wednesday afternoon, so it did not even soak in for more than 4 - 10 hours.

Mussons took the soil on two trucks to their shop and stored it overnight, then took it to Lincoln County the next morning. Approximately 38 cubic yards.

Soils at 3 feet smelled clean, but we went a little deeper to 4.5 just to be sure. Lab data were rushed, so we should have that next week early.

The Lat/Lons I gave you were about 50 feet off. I'll get the right ones in a short report.

All in all it is, I think, resolved and done. Lab data will confirm.

Also – can we change the name of the spill from City of Rhinelander to Municipal Well and Pump? They are the RP as you know. Have a good weekend!
