Hi Jason, I have a few comments on the Pizza Place SI report (03-03-562914). Please see below. Please call if you have any questions. Thanks, Carrie

Please refer to the 2nd paragraph of the executive summary. Just to clarify; DNR never received the tank report until Mike Schradle sent it to the department after he received the RP letter-(which was sent to him based on PZ-14 results and information of the presence of historic tanks). Mike requested the Tank report from DATCP. The department reviewed the tank report, and upon review determined the report did not meet DNR requirements of no further investigation because the total hydrocarbons of gasoline beneath the dispensers were 2,200 and 2,500 ppm. The areas under the dispenser were not re-tested after the excavation; only the supply lines were tested.

If you are going to sample the following wells from Wild Card, the you should state the well origins on the tables (see MW-7, PZ-6, PZ-7, PZ-11). It was confusing at first why these wells were not sampled.

Do you feel the vertical extent is defined? I ask because PZ-14 is screened at 61.80' bgs and is pretty hot (see 2nd attachment), whereas MW-1 & 2 are screened at 58' each. If you can justify your reasoning-great!

I agree further GW monitoring is needed.

FYI: Here is some waterway information I researched for the Wild Card site. .29 miles to the west is Skinaway Lake(64.20 acres), located in Barron & Polk counties. It is a shallow seepage lake with a maximum depth of 10'. There are 25 acres pf wetlands to the north of the Site. Approximately .10 miles to the north is Elbow Lake (a 12-acre seepage lake, max depth 5 feet). Mud Lake lies .71 miles to the east and has a max depth of 4 feet and is 37 acres.
