You search for the site based upon BRRTS #, address, name, etc. In the database you can review (I suggest) those sites closure documents. All the info is there.

Wild Card BRRTS# 03-03-110339

Davis BRRTS# 03-03-000273

Davis does not have GW issues (hence the need for revisions)

The correct drawing to use is actually in your closure packet as B.3.b, however, Metco used an incorrect B.3.b in the notifications
