Dear Erin:

This letter responds to your letter dated August 15, 2014 requesting information on the CHS Inc. Grain Terminal in Superior Wisconsin and the use or storage of chemicals containing tributyltin or mercury. The following items respond to questions in your letter.


- CHS has reviewed the chemical inventory and past operations and found no evidence or indication that tributyhltin or mercury were ever used or stored at the terminal.
- CHS has owned and operated the terminal since construction in 1941. The facility has always been used as a grain terminal.
- The terminal has had no hazardous substances spills and no known groundwater contamination. There was one release to surface water that happened October 17, 2013 involving a small amount of mineral oil.
- There have been no environmental investigation or remediation efforts at the facility.
- Enclosed with this letter is a figure showing the facility layout.
- Painting activities are limited to maintenance on building and grain handling equipment. CHS has not conducted painting or maintenance of vessels.


Harvest States C03869, L02999 Receiving Water Credit **Determination Map**
