On November 13, 2017 The Department of Natural Resources (the Department) has received the reports titled *Phase I Hazardous Materials Assessment Project ID 6997-03-00, E. Fifth Street, Washburn Street to Fairview Avenue – Local Street City of Shawano, Shawano County, Wisconsin dated April 17, 2017 and Phase 2.5 Subsurface Investigation Project ID 6997-03-00, E. Fifth Street, Washburn Street to Fairview Avenue – Local Street City of Shawano, Shawano County, Wisconsin dated August 31, 2017.*

After a review of the Phase 2.5 Subsurface investigation the Department looked at the data of the recent investigation and that of the preexisting sites Grosskopf Bus Company (BRRTS #: 03-59-001935) and Fifth & Ellis St – Phantom (State Lead) (BRRTS #: 02-59-563634). The soil data table showed all samples from the six borings were below the detection limits. PID readings of the soil were taken but, according to Robert E. Lee & Associates, Inc. (REL), the detector was malfunctioning and could not be calibrated in the field. Groundwater was sampled from four of the six boring locations: TW-1, TW-3, TW-5, and TW-6. TW-1 and TW-3 contained concentrations of methyl tert-butyl ether (MTBE) and TW-6 showed concentrations of cis- 1,2-dichloroethene below both the Enforcement Standard (ES) and Preventative Action Limit (PAL). TW-5 had Tetrachloroethene (PCE) concentrations above the PAL but below the ES. The PVOCs detected in groundwater are associated with the contaminated groundwater from the closed Grosskopf Bus Inc (BRRTS #: 03-59-001935) site. The chlorinated solvent detected is associated with the open 5th & Ellis St – Phantom (State Lead) (BRRTS #: 02-59-563634) site.

Therefore, I have filed these reports in the existing case files and there will be no further action by the Department at this time.

I also concur with the standard special provision provided.
