Mr. LeRoy,

Georgia-Pacific LLC (GP) is in receipt of your letter dated September 14, 2020 regarding the above-referenced matter. GP understands the comments offered by Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) relative to the previously submitted Site Investigation Work Plan dated June 8, 2020. In consideration of the DNR's comments and requested implementation schedule, GP offers the following responses.

- <u>DNR Comment</u>: The DNR requests the submittal of the emerging contaminant/PFAS scoping by October 17, 2020, so that it may be approved prior to completing the final work plan.
- <u>GP Response</u>: GP respectfully requests an extension of the due date for the above-referenced scoping document. GP proposes to prepare and submit the above-referenced scoping document on or before Friday, December 11, 2020. GP anticipates that the scoping document will include a proposal to install a network of at least three groundwater monitoring wells for analysis of PFAS compounds. Given that GP anticipates contracting with a different environmental consultant for this work and the investigation will utilize separate personnel and equipment, GP believes that the emerging contaminant/PFAS assessment can be conducted in parallel with the other investigation work.
- <u>DNR Comment</u>: The DNR requests the submittal of a revised site investigation work plan by November 17, 2020 to address the comments identified above. The work plan must comply with the requirements identified in Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.09(2).
- <u>GP Response</u>: The nature of DNR's comments significantly expand the scope of the previously proposed investigation and the additionally requested analytical data may also require multiple field mobilizations. Nonetheless, GP will prepare and submit a revised Site Investigation Work Plan by the requested date of November 17, 2020, along with the requisite review fee. Given the timing of this deliverable and the anticipated review period, GP anticipates that investigation at the above-referenced site can resume in Spring 2021.

GP appreciates the DNR's consideration of an extension to the submittal of the PFAS scoping deliverable proposed above. Please feel free to let me know if you have questions or wish to discuss.
