#### Hi Tauren,

Nice to chat with you. Here's my contact info.

Keep me posted when you find out about anyone living or working in the property.

As I mentioned, our urgent concern is pregnant women, or women of child bearing age (especially if actively trying to become pregnant). If these individuals are not present at the property, then the urgency is reduced a bit from a health standpoint.

The other thing I wanted to mention is that, depending on what the site investigation finds, if the contamination extends to neighboring properties (either by plume or preferential pathways, such as utilities) then we will need to evaluate the health and VI risks at those neighboring properties as well.

As I mentioned, I will contact the local health department and give them a heads up about this site.

Hi Liz,

I wanted to provide you with information regarding a newly discovered chlorinated solvent release at the Allyn Property located at 111 Steele St in Algoma. Primarily PCE (TCE and vinyl chloride also) was detected in soil and groundwater above standards. Please refer to Tables 1 and 2 in the attached Phase II ESA or Work Plan for concentrations of each compound. The hired consultant has been conducting additional soil and groundwater investigation. I should have a submittal coming in soon for the additional work. I also told the consultant that the vapor pathway will need to be assessed (Please refer to attached notice to proceed email). This is the first newly opened chlorinated solvent case I have had so if you need anything else from me for this DHS notification, please let me know.
