Hi Adam,

I talked to Cindy and Don Brittnacher this morning. Cindy is starting to look into the apartment complex property (109 Steele Street) today. She will be getting in touch with the City to find out who the property owner is and make initial contacts to try to find out who occupies the building and provide information on vapor intrusion. I told her to use my contact information in case the City or property owner has follow up questions. She plans to follow up with me later today on her progress.

I also talked to Don from OMNNI this morning. He said that John Emery is making contact with vapor mitigation contractors and will be following up with DNR and health. I also told Don to relay to John to call Cindy so she has John's contact information on hand. Don said that John

understands that the focus right now is on the more immediate vapor investigation and that additional investigation of soil and groundwater is still needed.

OMMNI, on behalf of John, is working on soliciting bids from SIGMA for two sub-slab vapor points with concurrent indoor air sampling in the apartment complex. OMNNI does not conduct vapor sampling, but instead contracts it out. At this point, John continues to retain OMNNI to represent him. I told Don they should try to get the vapor sampling completed at the apartment complex before the mitigation system is running at the source property to determine under background ("natural") conditions if there is a vapor concern.
