Good Morning Tauren,

I just wanted to give you a quick update on Allyns, as a reference only. This is not a submittal.

We mobilized to the site on 10/31/18 and installed the 2 monitoring wells and 1 piezometer. We shifted MW5 south and into the roadway. That is as far south as we could comfortably go due to utilities in the area (approximately 40' south of the initially proposed location). Additionally, we had to push MW6 a bit further to the east due to utilities (overhead line).

We also obtained one VOC lab sample per well in an unsaturated zone just above the water table (typical sample was 14-15' bgs).

On the vapor side, we were able to obtain an access agreement for 109 Steele (to the east) with Curtis' help. Unfortunately, Curtis tried multiple times on Wednesday to contact the property owners/tenants to the west to no avail. Therefore, we decided to hold off on the vapor sampling until we could make contact with the owners and try to get it all done at once.

I've attached a map for your reference of the new well locations. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know.
