I did get a chance look at the report. I don't have any reservations with you conducting the Q2 groundwater sampling.

Overall takeaways:

- I agree that the site investigation is not complete, additional vertical and/or horizontal delineation will be needed.
 - Both soil and groundwater contamination appears to have migrated into the right-ofway and/or offsite.
- As I have told Don in the past, vapor investigations typically require one sample event during the heating season and one sample during the cooling season to ensure vapor is not an issue. I can provide the data and have a discussion with our regional vapor expert (Jennifer Borski) to see what she recommends, then get back to you on that.
