Ken,

Regarding the Wagner Oil Spill (02-34-577387), I discussed the Jan. 5, 2021 groundwater monitoring results with the Peer Review Committee yesterday.

As PFAS compounds were detected in most of the wells/piezometers and this was the first PFAS monitoring event, it was recommended to request additional PFAS monitoring to determine plume concentration/stability trend over time.

It was also noted the PVOOC contamination appears to have decreased over time.
