Hi David,

Sorry I missed your call the other day. I have reviewed both notifications and data for the utility excavation work that was completed in October 2016. The data from the Thermo Fisher notification indicated that metals were present but in-line with Wisconsin background threshold values (BTVs). However, the split sampling data and notification indicated lead above the BTV and soil to groundwater residual contaminant levels (RCLs) and a detection of TCE above the soil to groundwater RCL, which warrants further investigation. Therefore, a responsible party (RP) letter will be issued to the property owner to further investigate the contamination found at the property. I wanted to provide notification to you prior to the RP letter being issued. If you have any questions or would like to discuss further, feel free to contact me.
