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Tauren:

I just received a call from one of the folks with ERM, the firm performing the investigation on the Thermo Fisher property south of 17th Street.

When measuring and sampling MW 2, they found about one foot of free product at a relative depth of about 13.5 feet from ground surface. He indicated that it appeared to be diesel fuel. McMahon, as I recall, did detect some odor in the soils during the well construction, but not as evident as this would indicate.

The well is on the former site of the Labor Hall and is immediately down gradient from a tavern. Other up-gradient possible sources appear to be few in number. Other, nearby City Wells did not indicate the presence of any similar contamination.

I will get in touch with you tomorrow to discuss further.
