I meant to copy you on the below email, so I apologize for missing you on the cc. After evaluation of the Phase I ESA and the Limited Phase II ESA consisting of soil borings and monitoring wells installed in the City right-of-way and City parking lot property surrounding the Suettinger property located at 1407 16<sup>th</sup> St, the DNR determined there was no source of chlorinated solvents on the Suettinger Property, so the chlorinated solvent contamination in groundwater was included into the open Hamilton Industries (Former) case. I am assuming with your discussions with the City, like you have with the other monitoring wells installed by the City on their Lot F property at 1401 E. River St, you will be able to get access to use these additional wells for monitoring.
