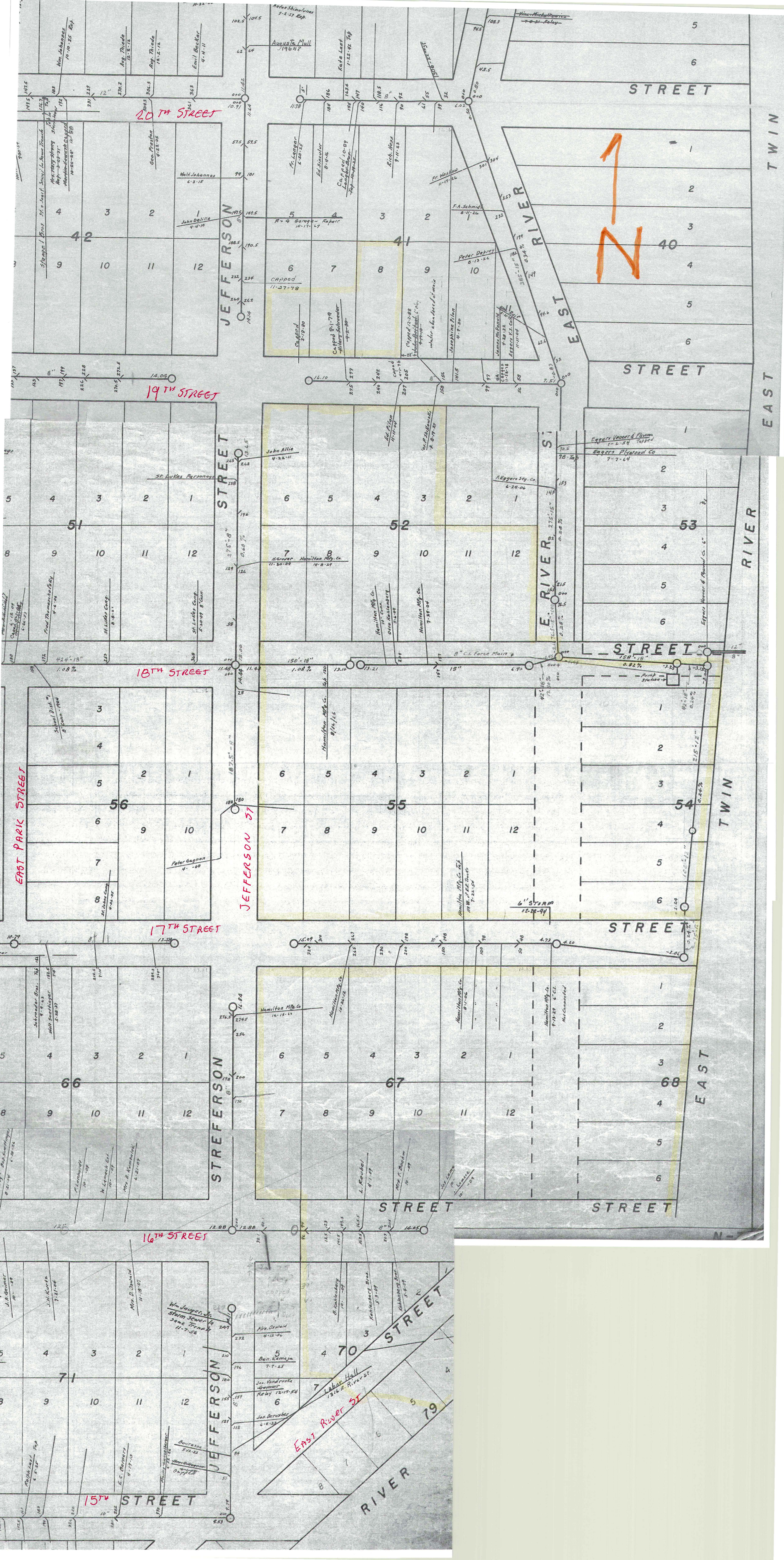

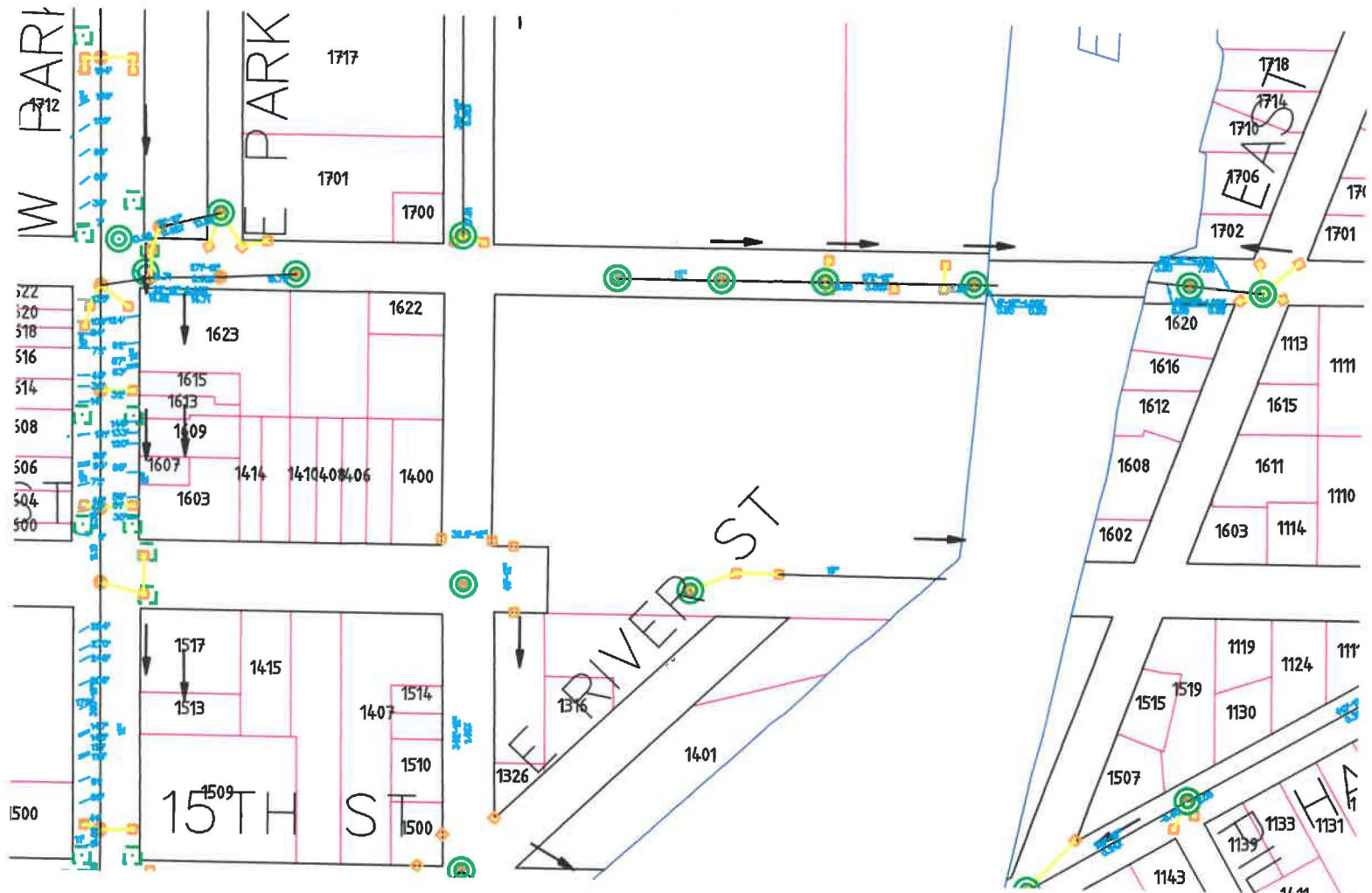

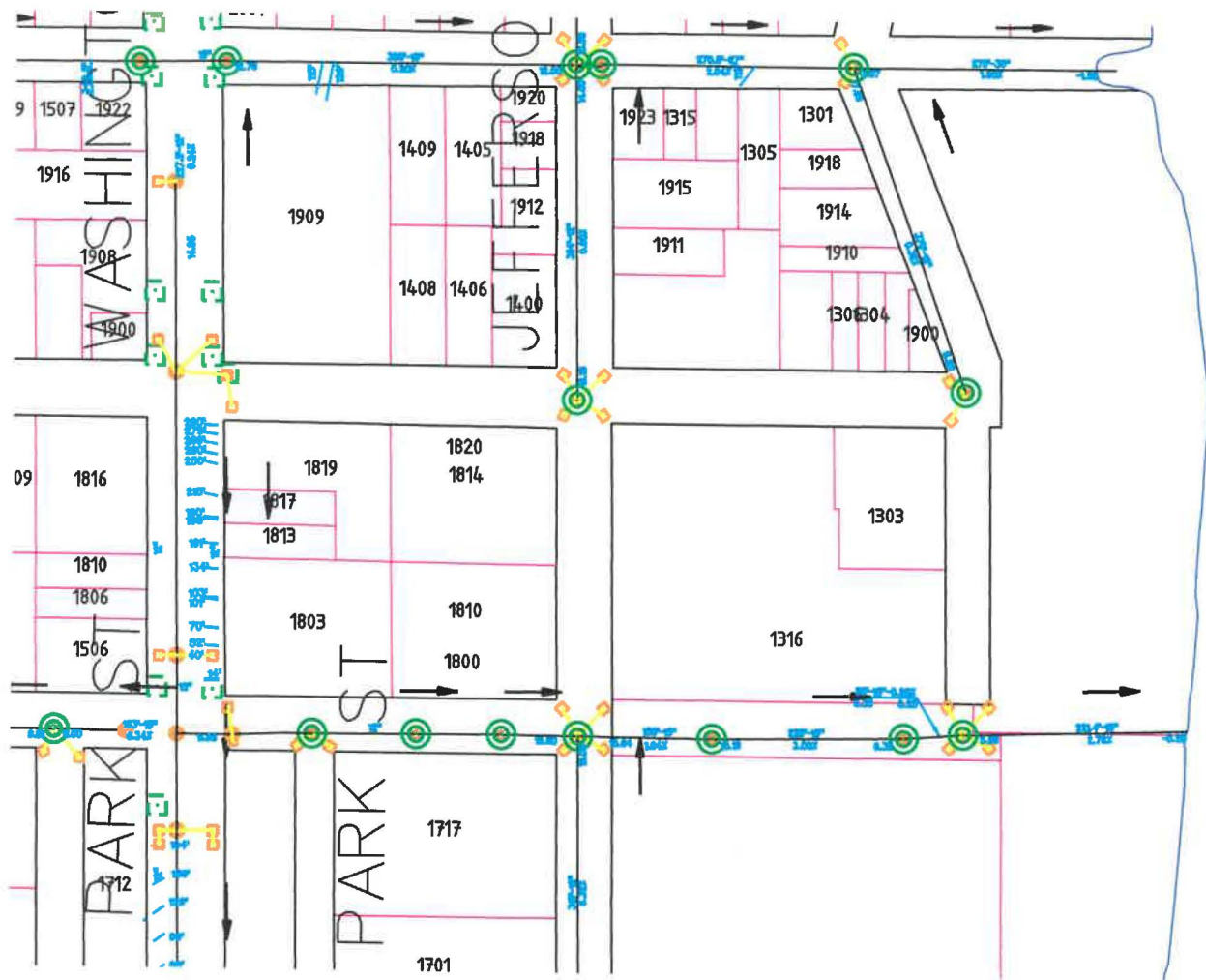

Hi Greg,

I am looking to see if the City of Two Rivers can provide historical and current utilities/utility laterals maps surrounding the former Thermo Fisher Property (google map of roads and other infrastructure below). I am trying to evaluate potential for contaminant utility migration, especially through former sanitary sewer lines, as these can be potential migratory routes due to how they are typically constructed. If contaminants were historically discharged to sanitary sewer, there may have been leaks along the line that could have caused additional soil and/or groundwater contamination. If I need to contact someone else with the City, please direct me to the correct contact.
