Hi David,

The DNR received the *Additional Evaluation of Polyfluorinated Alkyl Substances (PFAS)* on April 12, 2023. As previously indicated in the DNR's Technical Assistance Review response letter dated May 4, 2022, the DNR indicated that additional sampling is needed before a determination can be made that PFAS is not associated with releases on-site.

Another round of PFAS sampling from either the entire monitoring well network (same as initial round) or a subset of the monitoring wells is necessary to confirm concentrations and provide additional groundwater data for evaluation of PFAS to meet requirements for the site investigation under Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 716. A brief work plan should be submitted if choosing a subset of monitoring wells.

Sorry it took a bit longer to follow up with other DNR staff in order to respond to this.
