As we discussed over the phone, the WDNR is currently requiring an evaluation of the potential for PFAS, or other emerging contaminants, to be present at all sites. Provide an evaluation of the potential for PFAS, or other emerging contaminants, to be present in environmental media as a result of the identified discharge at the Bright Cleaners (02-41-580017) site. The evaluation should include whether PFAS or other contaminants were used or stored at the site based on the site history, duration of use, etc. Based on this evaluation, make a determination whether emerging contaminants sampling is necessary at the site. More details about the emerging contaminants scoping evaluation can be found in the attached DNR letter "Reminder to Include Evaluation of Emerging Contaminants in Site Investigation," dated 8/17/2020. Submit your evaluation and determination in writing to me either via email or the WDNR e-submittal portal. Feel free to contact me if you have questions about this request or if you would like additional direction on what to include in the evaluation.

Subsequently, resubmittal of the case closure request may be appropriate if emerging contaminants sampling is determined to be unnecessary.
