On behalf of Marquette University, Ramboll US Corporation (Ramboll) submits this letter to notify the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) that on March 19, 2018, soil relocation activities began to temporarily store excavated benching soils from the Marquette University Athletic and Human Performance Research Center (AHPRC) site, located at 1201-1221 West Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin (BRRTS No. 02-41-580746), to the Former One-Hour Valet Dry Cleaners site, located at 1214-1222 West Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin (BRRTS No. 02-41-152248). This notification is provided in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code (WAC) NR 718.05.

March 19, 2018

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Soils excavated for the construction of the proposed AHPRC building are being temporarily staged off-site at the Former One-Hour Valet Dry Cleaners site, in accordance with the WDNR-approved *NR 718.12 Exemption Request and Soil Management Plan*.
