NR 718.05(i) - NOTIFICATION OF STORAGE FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE MARQUETTE AHPRC SITE, 1201-1221 WEST WELLS STREET, MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN; BRRTS NO. 02-41-580746

Dear Mr. Nobile:

On behalf of Marquette University, Ramboll US Corporation (Ramboll) submits this letter to notify the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) that the temporary storage of excavated benching soils from the Marquette University Athletic and Human Performance Research Center (AHPRC) site, located at 1201-1221 West Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin (Bureau for Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System [BRRTS] No. 02-41-580746) on the Former One-Hour Valet Dry Cleaners site, located at 1214-1222 West Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin (BRRTS No. 02-41-152248) will extend beyond 90 days. The WDNR was notified of the soil relocation on March 19, 2018, when temporary soil storage activities were initiated. It is anticipated that the stockpiled soils could remain on the Former On-Hour Valet Dry Cleaners site until mid-July, depending on the weather. This notification is provided in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code (WAC) NR 718.05(i).

Soils excavated for the construction of the proposed AHRPC building are being temporarily staged off-site at the Former One-Hour Valet Dry Cleaners site for subsequent use as backfill during the AHPRC construction, in accordance with the WDNR-approved *NR 718.12 Exemption Request and Soil Management Plan*. Additional notification information required by WAC NR 718.05(i) is provided in Attachment A.
