EnviroForensics, LLC (EnviroForensics) has prepared this response letter on behalf of OHM Holdings, Inc. (OHM) to satisfy case closure requirements for the referenced OHM Wauwatosa (Site). In a letter dated April 7, 2020, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources asked open BRRTs cases to assess emerging contaminants including perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), 1,4-dioxane and others.

The Site is a former service station that sold petroleum fuels before its purchase by OHM. All petroleum tanks and ancillary equipment were removed from the site. The site investigation of the petroleum compounds shows the release originates from the petroleum storage and dispensing equipment. To the best of our knowledge, and according to the WDNR emerging contaminants web page, PFAS compounds, 1-4-dioxane, and other emerging contaminants are decidedly not associated with petroleum fuel products. Therefore, the site is reasonably not a source for releases to the environment from these emerging contaminants.
