Patrick,

Sorry for the delay. Below is a brief summary of the spill as well as an attached picture.

On 8/29/17 at approximately 11am approximately 15 gallons of hydraulic fluid leaked on to the rock ground in our quarry as a result of a hydraulic line failure on one of our haul trucks. Absorbent material was applied and the material was cleaned up. I would estimate 100% of the liquid was recovered because the surface where the spill occurred is non-porous (extremely hard rock). The attached photo shows the location of where the spill occurred (post clean up). If you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask. Thanks again and have a great Labor Day Weekend,
