Lower Fox River and Green Bay Superfund Site, WI

Dear Messrs. Heath and Heyde:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) have reviewed the Operable Units (OUs) 2-5 Remedial Action Certification of RA Completion Report (RA Report) for the Lower Fox River and Green Bay Superfund Site, WI, dated July 15, 2022. The RA Report was submitted by Tetra Tech, Inc. on behalf of NCR Corporation in accordance with Section 4.5(d) of the Statement of Work attached to the Consent Decree (CD) with NCR Corporation and Appvion, Inc. Docket No. 10-cv-00910-WCG, entered August 23, 2017.

The RA performed at OUs 2-5 consisted of excavation and capping of PCB-contaminated sediment, off-site disposal of contaminated material, and engineering controls. The RA Report documents the completion of the remedy selected in the December 2002 OUs 1 and 2 Record of Decision (ROD), the June 2003 OUs 3, 4 and 5 ROD, the June 2007 OUs 2-5 ROD amendment, and the February 2010 OUs 2-5 Explanation of Significant Differences.

EPA hereby approves the RA Report for OUs 2-5. Based on EPA's approval of the RA Report, and in accordance with Section 4.5(f) of the SOW in the CD, EPA certifies that, for the purposes of the CD, the work performed for OUs 2-5 is Construction Complete.

Issuance of the Certification of RA Construction Completion will not affect remaining obligations under the CD, including long term monitoring, cap maintenance and institutional controls. This work must continue to be implemented by the responsible parties pursuant to the terms of the

above referenced CD and the related CD with P.H. Glatfelter Company and Georgia-Pacific Consumer Products L.P. entered on March 14, 2019.
