The Sigma Group, Inc. (Sigma) has completed an AAI Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of the above noted property located in Watertown, Wisconsin. Based on the information reviewed from August 7 through August 23, 2019, a recognized environmental condition (REC) as defined by the All Appropriate Inquiry (AAI) ASTM Standard E-1527-13, has been identified at the subject property which includes the following:

• The subject property is an open Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) site (BRRTS #03-28-583075). A review of analytical results from soil samples collected during a tank removal site assessment completed in September 2018 identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the underground storage tank (UST) excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019. The LUST case remains open.

Additionally, a historical REC (HREC) was identified at the subject property which includes the following:

• The subject property is also a closed LUST site (BRRTS #03-28-542497). A gasoline filling station operated at the subject property since 1963 and two USTs were removed in May 1987 (three USTs were installed as replacements, which were removed in September 2018 – discussed above). A release associated with the USTs removed in 1987 was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce (COMM) in a letter dated May 9, 2006.

Based on the no further action determination by COMM in 2006, there is no regulatory requirement to further investigate the residual contamination located at the subject property from the 1987 UST removals; however, residual impacts from the LUST case could be encountered in the event that subsurface soils are excavated in the future. Contaminated material that is discovered and removed would require appropriate management in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations.

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#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Mr. Tom Coogan, on behalf of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), retained The Sigma Group, Inc. (Sigma) of Milwaukee, Wisconsin to conduct an AAI Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of property located at 905 East Main Street in Watertown, Wisconsin (subject property). The purpose of the environmental assessment was to identify any recognized environmental conditions (RECs), as defined by ASTM in its Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments (E 1527-13), on the subject property. To perform the service, Sigma compiled a site history, reviewed available regulatory documents, reviewed area geology and hydrogeology and conducted limited site observations between August 7 and August 23, 2019.

RECs, as defined by ASTM in its E1527-13 Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments (All Appropriate Inquiry), include the presence or likely presence of any hazardous substances or petroleum products in, on, or at a property: 1) due to any release to the environment; 2) under conditions indicative of a release to the environment; or 3) under conditions that pose a material threat of a future release to the environment. The term includes hazardous substances and petroleum products even under conditions in compliance with the law. This term is not intended to include *de minimis* conditions that do not generally present a material risk to human health or the environment and would not be the subject of an enforcement action if brought to the attention of the appropriate authorities. Conditions determined to be de minimis are not recognized environmental conditions.

The subject property, an approximate O.19-acre parcel, is located at 905 East Main Street in the City of Watertown, Jefferson County, Wisconsin. At the time of this assessment, the subject property was improved with a 442 square-foot convenience store with attached cooler reportedly constructed in 1960 and an approximate 96 square-foot shed. Historically, the subject property was developed since at least 1895. Historical occupants between 1895 and 1963 included a grocery, stables, a feed warehouse and a storefront with storage buildings. Since 1963, the subject property has been occupied by a gasoline station. The last gasoline underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed from the subject property in 2018. At the time of this assessment, the subject property was unoccupied.

A search of available environmental records was conducted by Environmental Data Resources Inc. (EDR). EDR identified the subject property in the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Solid & Hazardous Waste Information Management System (SHWIMS), Enforcement and Compliance History Information (ECHO), Facility Index System (FINDS), Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST), Recovered Government Archive (RGA)-LUST, Historical Auto Station, Underground Storage Tank (UST), Tier 2 Facility Listings (Tier 2) and Asbestos databases researched by EDR.

The subject property was identified in the RCRA, SHWIMS, ECHO and FINDS databases as a RCRA non-generator. Non-generators do not presently generate hazardous waste. The subject property was historically a generator of ignitable waste. No violations were on file for the property.

The subject property was identified in the LUST and RGA-LUST databases with two separate LUST cases. The WDNR file for the subject property was reviewed.

## BRRTS #03-28-542497 Closed LUST – Marathon Gas Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Based on documentation in the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) file for the closed LUST #03-28-542497, a gasoline filling station had operated at the site since 1963. A 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline underground storage tank (UST) and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST were removed on May 1, 1987. Three unleaded gasoline USTs (6,000-gallon, 8,000-gallon and 10,000-gallon) were installed as replacements in May 1987.

A release associated with the USTs was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Phase II activities completed at the site in February 2005 consisted of the advancement of five soil borings and collection and submittal of soil samples for laboratory analysis. The extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater at the site were subsequently defined to meet WDNR requirements through the completion of nine additional soil borings and six groundwater monitoring wells. Select soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis and one to two rounds of groundwater samples were collected and submitted for laboratory analysis.

Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce in a letter dated May 9, 2006.

BRRTS #03-28-583075 - Open LUST - Former Marathon Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Remaining unleaded gasoline USTs (two 8,000-gallon and one 12,000-gallon), associated piping and three associated dispensers were removed from the site in September 2018. A review of analytical results from the soil samples collected during the tank removal site assessment, identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath the former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the UST excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019 and a new BRRTS number assigned to the site. The LUST case remains open.

The subject property was identified in the Historical Auto Station and UST databases as a registered UST site with a 6,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST, an 8,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST and a 10,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on September 19, 2018 and a 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline UST and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on May 1, 1987. The UST removals led to the LUST cases discussed above.

The subject property was identified in the Tier 2 database with reportable quantities of gasoline historically located at the subject property. No violations were identified for the property.

The subject property was identified in the Asbestos database with an abatement/demolition project completed on September 25, 2018. No violations were identified for the property.

In addition to the subject property, EDR identified several properties on one or more of the environmental databases researched by EDR. Based on the relative distance between the reported sites and the subject property and/or the reported site status, the identified sites are not expected to impact the subject property.

The Phase I Environmental Site Assessment has been performed in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E1527-13. This assessment has not revealed evidence of recognized environmental conditions at the subject property except for the following:

• The subject property is an open Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) site (BRRTS #03-28-583075). A review of analytical results from soil samples collected during a tank removal site assessment completed in September 2018 identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the underground storage tank (UST) excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019. The LUST case remains open.

Additionally, a historical REC (HREC) was identified at the subject property which includes the following:

• The subject property is also a closed LUST site (BRRTS #03-28-542497). A gasoline filling station operated at the subject property since 1963 and two USTs were removed in May 1987 (three USTs were installed as replacements, which were removed in September 2018 – discussed above). A release associated with the USTs removed in 1987 was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce (COMM) in a letter dated May 9, 2006.

Based on the no further action determination by COMM in 2006, there is no regulatory requirement to further investigate the residual contamination located at the subject property from the 1987 UST removals; however, residual impacts from the LUST case could be encountered in the event that subsurface soils are excavated in the future. Contaminated material that is discovered and removed would require appropriate management in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations.

With the exception of time constraints there were no limiting conditions to this report. Where observations were limited, Sigma renders no opinion as to the presence of hazardous substances, wastes or contamination potential.

The conclusions included in this assessment report should not be construed as legal advice. #### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Purpose

Mr. Tom Coogan, on behalf of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), retained The Sigma Group, Inc. (Sigma) of Milwaukee, Wisconsin to conduct an AAI Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of property located at 905 East Main Street in Watertown, Wisconsin (subject property). The purpose of the environmental assessment was to identify any recognized environmental conditions (RECs), as defined by ASTM in its Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments (E 1527-13), on the subject property. To perform the service, Sigma compiled a site history, reviewed available regulatory documents, reviewed area geology and hydrogeology and conducted limited site observations between August 7 and August 23, 2019. The findings of the assessment are summarized in this report.

The ASTM Standard E 1527-13 defines a REC as:

"The presence or likely presence of any hazardous substances or petroleum products in, on, or at a property: 1) due to any release to the environment; 2) under conditions indicative of a release to the environment; or 3) under conditions that pose a material threat of a future release to the environment." The term includes hazardous substances or petroleum products even under conditions in compliance with laws. The term is not intended to include *de minimis* conditions that generally do not present a material risk of harm to public health or the environment and that generally would not be the subject of enforcement action if brought to the attention of appropriate governmental agencies. Conditions determined to be *de minimis* are not recognized environmental conditions".

The ASTM Standard E 1527-13 defines a controlled recognized environmental condition (CREC) as:

"A recognized environmental condition resulting from a past release of hazardous substances or petroleum products that has been addressed to the satisfaction of the applicable regulatory authority (for example, as evidenced by the issuance of a no further action letter or equivalent, or meeting risk-based criteria established by regulatory authority), with hazardous substances or petroleum products allowed to remain in place subject to the implementation of required controls (for example, property use restrictions, activity and use limitations, institutional controls, or engineering controls)".

The ASTM Standard E 1527-13 defines a historical recognized environmental condition (HREC) as:

"A past release of any hazardous substances or petroleum products that has occurred in connection with the property and has been addressed to the satisfaction of the applicable regulatory authority or meeting unrestricted use criteria established by a regulatory authority, without subjecting the property to any required controls (for example, property use restrictions, activity and use limitations, institutional controls, or engineering controls)".

#### 1.2 Methodology

Research of the property evaluated its historical use and examined the generation, treatment, storage, and disposal of hazardous chemicals, materials, substances, and wastes for potential sources of environmental concern. Research included a review of reasonably ascertainable records, interviews of knowledgeable local and state officials, and a site reconnaissance.

#### 1.3 Significant Assumptions

This report was prepared under constraints of cost, time, and scope, and reflects a limited assessment and evaluation rather than a total, complete, or extensive assessment and evaluation. Sigma's review was performed using the degree of care and skill ordinarily exercised under similar localities. No other warranty or guarantee, expressed or implied, is made as to the conclusions and recommendations included in this report.

The findings of this report, to the best of our knowledge, are valid as of the date of this review. However, changes in the conditions of a property can occur with the passage of time, whether due to natural processes or the works of man on this or adjacent properties. In addition, changes in applicable or appropriate standards may occur, whether they result from legislation, from the broadening of knowledge, or from other reasons. Accordingly, the findings of this report may be invalidated wholly or partially by changes outside our control.

Conclusions in this report represent our professional judgment and are limited to those site conditions and potential impacts from neighboring properties that could be discovered under the scope of services authorized by the proposal. The conclusions presented were based on an inspection of the property and a review of relevant records.

Sigma attempted to review all reasonably ascertainable, practically reviewable information regarding the history of the subject property; however, data gaps were encountered during preparation of this report. It is Sigma's opinion that the data gaps do not significantly affect, as defined by ASTM E1527-13, the ability to identify recognized environmental conditions in connection with the subject property.

Additionally, Sigma attempted to review all pertinent regulatory agency files for the subject property and adjoining properties; however, time constraints limited the regulatory file review. Based on a review of on-line, historical and municipal records, user and owner provided information and regulatory information provided by Environmental Data Resources (EDR) it is Sigma's opinion that the regulatory file review constraints do not significantly affect, as defined by ASTM E1527-13, the ability to identify recognized environmental conditions in connection with the subject property.

The conclusions and interpretations of this report do not collectively define all the risks associated with purchase or other use of the property. Should you, our client, or other interested parties, wish to further reduce the risks associated with undiscovered or unquantified environmental impacts, you may want to consider having additional assessment activities performed such as collecting and analyzing soil, groundwater, or other appropriate samples for compounds of relevant and particular concern, or complete other investigation activities as appropriate.

#### 2.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

#### 2.1 Location, Legal Description, and General Characteristics

The subject property, an approximate 0.19-acre parcel, is located at 905 East Main Street in the City of Watertown, Jefferson County, Wisconsin. A legal description and GIS image of the subject property, obtained from Jefferson County, are included in **Appendix A**. The subject property location is presented on **Figures 1 and 2**.

#### 2.2 Current Use of the Property

At the time of this assessment, the subject property was unoccupied. The subject property was most recently occupied by a gasoline station.

#### 2.3 Site and Vicinity Characteristics

The subject property is located on the southeast corner of East Main Street and College Avenue within an area of Watertown that is comprised primarily of residential properties with some commercial properties. The City of Watertown has included the subject property within an area that is zoned Central Business (CB).

#### 2.4 Descriptions of Structures, Roads, and Other Improvements on the Site

At the time of this assessment, the subject property was improved with a 442 square-foot convenience store with attached cooler constructed in 1960 and an approximate 96 square-foot shed.

Utilities provided to the subject property include water, gas, electric, communications, and sewer. The City of Watertown supplies water and wastewater service to the subject property.

#### 2.5 Current Uses of the Adjoining Properties

At the time of this assessment, adjoining properties included Main Street then residential properties and a restaurant to the northeast of the subject property, residential properties to the southeast of the subject property and College Avenue then residential properties and an office building to the west of the subject property. A Site Plan and Area Map are included as **Figure 2** of this report.

#### 3.0 USER-PROVIDED INFORMATION

#### 3.1 Title Records

Sigma attempted to review available current land title records for environmental cleanup liens and other activity and use limitations, such as engineering controls and institutional controls for the subject property. Deed information was not available at the printing of this report. Although deed information was not available for review for the subject property, based on the information that was available for review, it is Sigma's opinion that the data gap does not significantly affect the ability to identify recognized environmental conditions in connection with the property.

#### 3.2 Environmental Liens or Activity and Use Limitations

In accordance with the ASTM standard, Sigma requested information from the WDNR, via Mr. Tom Coogan, regarding known environmental liens on the subject property. Mr. Coogan reported that there is a closed and an open Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) case at the subject property (discussed below).

#### 3.3 Specialized Knowledge

In accordance with the ASTM standard, Sigma requested information from Mr. Coogan regarding information about previous ownership or uses of the property that may be material to identifying recognized environmental conditions. Mr. Coogan reported that there is a closed and an open LUST case at the subject property. Sigma reviewed the WDNR file for the subject property. A summary of the file information is provided below.

BRRTS #03-28-542497 Closed LUST – Marathon Gas Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Based on documentation in the Wisconsin WDNR file for the closed LUST #03-28-542497, a gasoline filling station had operated at the site since 1963. A 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline underground storage tank (UST) and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST were removed on May 1, 1987. Three unleaded gasoline USTs (6,000-gallon, 8,000-gallon and 10,000-gallon) were installed as replacements in May 1987.

A release associated with the USTs was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Phase II activities completed at the site in February 2005 consisted of the advancement of five soil borings and collection and submittal of soil samples for laboratory analysis. The extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater at the site were subsequently defined to meet WDNR requirements through the completion of nine additional soil borings and six groundwater monitoring wells. Select soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis and one to two rounds of groundwater samples were collected and submitted for laboratory analysis.

BRRTS #03-28-583075 - Open LUST - Former Marathon Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Remaining unleaded gasoline USTs (two 8,000-gallon and one 12,000-gallon), associated piping and three associated dispensers were removed from the site in September of 2018. A review of analytical results from the soil samples collected during the tank removal site assessment, identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath the former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the UST excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019 and a new BRRTS number assigned to the site. The LUST case remains open.

#### 3.4 Valuation Reduction of Environmental Issues

In accordance with the ASTM standard, Sigma requested information from Mr. Coogan regarding value reduction of the subject property to comparable properties. Mr. Coogan reported that value information was not available to him.

#### 3.5 Owner, Property Manager, and Occupant Information

On August 20, 2019, Sigma interviewed Mr. Benjamin Wehemeier, Administrator with Jefferson County, who owns the subject property. Mr. Wehemeier reported that the subject property was historically occupied by a gasoline station. The USTs associated with

gas station operations were closed/removed in 2018 and soil impacts were identified. With the exception of contamination identified during the UST removals (discussed in Section 3.3), Mr. Wehemeier had no knowledge of fill material, environmental liens, spills or any other environmental concerns associated with the parcel.

#### 3.6 Reasons for Performing Phase I

The purpose of this report is to qualify for the innocent landowner defense to CERCLA liability and to assist the user in making business decisions in regard to the subject property.

#### 4.0 RECORDS REVIEW

#### 4.1 Standard Environmental Record Sources

Sigma utilized the services of Environmental Data Resources (EDR) to provide regulatory data, meeting the ASTM Standard E 1527-13, from Federal and State agencies. The federal regulatory data includes the National Priorities List (NPL), the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) notifiers, the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Information System (CERCLIS) database, and the Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS) database. The state data includes the Leaking Underground Storage Tanks (LUST) list, the Registered Underground Storage Tank list, and the State Solid Waste Facilities/Landfill Sites list. During review of the data provided by EDR, Sigma focused on sites within a 1.0-mile radius or less of the property. The EDR summary report is included as **Appendix B** of this Phase I Environmental Site Assessment report. The findings of select inventories are discussed below.

#### 4.1.1 National Priority List

The EPA publishes a National Priorities List (NPL) of sites included in the "Superfund" program as authorized by CERCLA and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA). EDR did not identify the subject property as a "Proposed" Superfund, Superfund or "Delisted" Superfund site, nor were "Proposed" Superfund, Superfund or "Delisted" Superfund sites identified within a 1.0-mile radius of the subject property.

4.1.2 Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Information System (CERCLIS)

The CERCLIS list is a compilation of known or suspected uncontrolled or abandoned hazardous waste sites that are under investigation or have been investigated by the EPA to determine if the site(s) should be remediated under the Superfund program. EDR did not identify the subject property as a CERCLIS or CERCLIS - No Further Remedial Action Planned (NFRAP) site, nor were CERCLIS or CERCLIS-NFRAP sites identified within a 0.50-mile radius of the subject property.

4.1.3 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Corrective Action Report (CORRACTS) The United States EPA maintains the CORRACTS database. The database includes RCRA facilities, which are undergoing corrective action due to a release of hazardous waste or constituents into the environment. EDR did not identify the subject property as a CORRACTS site, nor were CORRACTS sites identified within a 1.0-mile radius of the subject property.

#### 4.1.4 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)

RCRA includes selective information compiled by the EPA on sites, which generate, store, transport, treat, and/or dispose of hazardous waste. EDR identified the subject property in the RCRA, Solid & Hazardous Waste Information Management System (SHWIMS), Enforcement and Compliance History Information (ECHO) and Facility Index System (FINDS) databases as a RCRA non-generator. Non-generators do not presently generate hazardous waste. The subject property was historically a generator of ignitable waste. No violations were on file for the property.

In addition to the subject property, EDR identified two RCRA hazardous waste generators within a 0.25-mile radius of the subject property. Based on the relative distance between the reported sites and the subject property and/or the site status, the RCRA sites are not expected to impact the subject property.

EDR did not identify the subject property as an RCRA-Treatment, storage, or disposal facility (TSDF), nor were RCRA-TSDFs identified within a 0.50-mile radius of the subject property.

#### 4.1.5 Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS)

The ERNS list contains information on reported releases of oil and hazardous substances. EDR did not identify the subject property as an ERNS site.

#### 4.1.6 State Hazardous Waste (SHWS)

The state hazardous waste site record, the Hazard Ranking List, is compiled by the WDNR and is generally the state's equivalent to the CERCLIS list. EDR did not identify the subject property as a state hazardous waste site, nor were SHWS sites identified within a 1.0-mile radius of the subject property.

#### 4.1.7 State Landfill

The state landfill list, the Registry of Waste Disposal Sites, is compiled by the WDNR and includes an inventory of solid waste disposal facilities or landfills. EDR did not identify the subject property as a state landfill or waste disposal site, nor were state landfill or waste disposal sites identified within a 0.50-mile radius of the subject property.

#### 4.1.8 Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST)

The LUST list is compiled by the WDNR and contains an inventory of reported LUST incidents. The subject property was identified in the LUST and Recovered Government Archive (RGA)-LUST databases with two separate LUST cases. Mr. Jeff Ackerman with the WDNR provided Sigma with the WDNR file for the subject property. The file review was discussed in Section 3.3.

In addition to the subject property, EDR identified 25 LUST sites within a 0.50-mile radius of the subject property. Based on the relative distance between the reported sites and the subject property and/or the closed status, the LUST sites are not expected to impact the subject property.

#### 4.1.9 Underground Storage Tanks (USTs)

The list of registered USTs is compiled by the State of Wisconsin and contains information on the site name, location, and number of tanks. The subject property was identified as a registered UST site with a 6,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST, an 8,000-gallon unleaded

gasoline UST and a 10,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on September 19, 2018 and a 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline UST and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on May 1, 1987. The UST removals led to the LUST cases discussed above.

In addition to the subject property, 15 registered UST sites were identified within a 0.25-mile radius of the subject property. Based on the relative distance between the reported sites and the subject property and/or the closed status, the UST sites are not expected to impact the subject property.

#### 4.2 Additional Environmental Record Sources

Sigma utilized EDR's services to provide regulatory data, exceeding the ASTM Standard E 1527-13, from Federal and State agencies. During review of the data provided by EDR, Sigma focused on sites within a 1.0-mile radius or less of the property.

#### 4.2.1 Wisconsin Environmental Repair Program (ERP)

The ERP program database is compiled by the WDNR and generally includes non-UST related spills. EDR did not identify the subject property as an ERP site; however, one ERP site was identified within a 0.50-mile radius of the subject property. Based on the relative distance between the reported site and the subject property and the closed status, the ERP site is not expected to negatively impact the subject property.

#### 4.2.2 Lists of Registered Aboveground Storage Tanks

The list of registered ASTs is compiled by the State of Wisconsin and contains information on the site name, location, and number of tanks. EDR did not identify the subject property as having a registered AST.

#### 4.2.3 Local Land Records

The Jefferson County Assessor's office was used to verify current recorded ownership information on the subject property. Jefferson County owns the subject property.

#### 4.2.4 Emergency Release Reports

The WDNR spills inventory was checked by EDR. EDR did not identify the subject property in the Spills database.

#### 4.2.5 RCRA Administration Action Tracking System (RAATS)

RAATS contains records based on the enforcement actions issued under RCRA pertaining to major violators and includes administrative and civil actions brought by the EPA. EDR did not identify the subject property in the RAATS database.

#### 4.2.6 Hazardous Materials Incident Report System (HMIRS)

HMIRS contains a log of hazardous material spill incidents, which have been reported to the United States Department of Transportation. EDR did not identify the subject property in the HMIRS database.

#### 4.2.7 PCB Activity Database (PADS)

PADS identifies generators, transporters, commercial storers and/or brokers, and disposers of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) who are required to notify the EPA of such activities. EDR did not identify the subject property in the PADS database.

#### 4.2.8 Facility Index System (FINDS)

The FINDS list contains facility information related to various environmental registrations and regulatory submissions performed by facilities including obtaining a hazardous waste generator number, annual reporting, etc. EDR identified the subject property in the FINDS database related to RCRA activities described in Section 4.1.4 of this report.

#### 4.2.9 Toxic Release Inventory System (TRIS)

TRIS identifies facilities, which release toxic chemicals to the air, water, and land in "reportable quantities" under Title III of SARA. EDR did not identify the subject property in the TRIS database.

#### 4.2.10 Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA)

TSCA identifies manufacturers and importers of chemical substances included on the TSCA Chemical Substance Inventory list. EDR did not identify the subject property in the TSCA database.

#### 4.2.11 Asbestos

The Asbestos database identifies properties with asbestos inspection information. The subject property was identified in the Asbestos database with an abatement/demolition project completed on September 25, 2018. No violations were identified for the property.

#### 4.2.12 Tier 2 Facility Listings (Tier 2)

The Tier 2 database includes listings of facilities which store or manufacture hazardous materials that submit an annual chemical inventory report. EDR identified the subject property in the Tier 2 database with reportable quantities of gasoline historically located at the subject property. No violations were identified for the property.

#### 4.2.13 Historical Auto Stations

The EDR Historical Auto Stations list includes listings of potential gas station/filling station/service station establishments. EDR identified the subject property in the Historical Auto Station database occupied by a gasoline service station from 1993 to 2011.

#### 4.2.14 Historical Cleaners

The EDR Historical Cleaners list includes potential dry cleaner sites. EDR did not identify the subject property as a historical cleaner site.

#### 4.2.15 Orphan Summary

Orphan sites are sites with incomplete addresses that could not be plotted on the EDR Radius Map. EDR reported one orphan site in its Radius Map report. Based on a review of the available address information, the site is not located at or adjacent to the subject property and is not expected to negatively impact the subject property.

#### 4.2.16 Tier I Vapor Encroachment Screen

Sigma conducted a Tier I Vapor Encroachment Screen (VES) in general conformance with the ASTM Standard 2600-10, Standard Guide for Vapor Encroachment Screening on Property Involved in Real Estate Transactions, dated June 1, 2010.

The purpose of the Tier I VES is to conduct an initial screening to identify a potential vapor encroachment condition (VEC) in the area of concern (AOC). A VEC is defined as the presence or likely presence of chemical(s) of concern vapors in the subsurface of the

subject property, caused by the release of vapors from contaminated soil or groundwater either on or near the subject property.

The Tier I VES is based on a review of regulatory databases, including but not limited to Federal, State, local, and tribal government records, as reported in the regulatory database report and based upon information obtained regarding historic and current use of the property. In addition, geographic location, distance, topography and hydrogeology, groundwater depth and flow information, local geology, and preferential migration pathways are reviewed and evaluated relative to the VES. Additionally, the Tier I VES was completed in general conformance with "Addressing Vapor Intrusion at Remediation & Redevelopment Sites Wisconsin" (RR-800) guidance published by the WDNR.

Potential VECs include the on-site LUST releases. It should be noted that the Tier I Vapor Encroachment Screen is not a formal assessment of indoor air quality and did not include testing or sampling.

#### 4.3 Physical Setting Sources

#### 4.3.1 United States Geologic Survey Topographic Map

A United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 Minute topographic map, designated as the Watertown, Wisconsin Quadrangle, was reviewed as part of this assessment (**Figure 1**). The subject property, which is located at an elevation of approximately 841 feet above mean sea level (MSL), is characterized by a topography that slopes toward the west northwest. The topography in the general vicinity of the subject property slopes toward the northwest. Surface water was not identified on the subject property.

#### 4.3.2 Regional Geology and Hydrogeology

Sigma reviewed the WDNR file for the subject property for information concerning the geology and hydrogeology beneath the subject property. Soils at the subject property consist of layers of fill underlain by silty clay or silty sand. Bedrock was not encountered during remedial investigation at the property. Groundwater across the site is generally seven to nine feet below grade. Soils at the site are permeable and groundwater flow is toward the southwest.

#### 4.4 Historical Use Information on the Subject Property

#### 4.4.1 Occupancy History

Originally a list of residents, city directories provide the name of resident or business and the type of business (if unclear) in a business index, a resident index and a street index. Available city directories, dating from 1963 to 2014, were reviewed in approximately five-year increments by Environmental Data Resources (EDR) for the subject property. Historical occupants of the subject property included Consolidated Stations Inc. (gas station) in 1963, 1965, 1970, 1974, 1979, 1984 and 1989, Speedway Self Service (Marathon) in 1995 and 2000 and Boparai LLC in 2005 and 2010. No other listings were available for the subject property. A release has been identified at the subject property (discussed in Section 3.3). A copy of the City Directory report is included in **Appendix C**.

#### 4.4.2 Aerial Photographs

Sigma reviewed aerial photographs for the subject property. Available photographs, obtained from EDR, were dated 1937, 1940, 1950, 1955, 1963, 1969, 1971, 1979, 1980, 1986, 1992, 2006, 2010, 2013 and 2017. Based on the scale and general nature of the historical photographs, only major development or construction projects could be confirmed.

Structures are depicted on the subject property in all of the photographs. Specific RECs were not identified on the subject property during the aerial photograph review. Copies of the photographs are included in **Appendix D**.

#### 4.4.3 Fire Insurance Maps

Sigma contacted EDR for available Sanborn Fire Insurance maps depicting the subject property. Developed in the late 1800's, the maps were used until approximately the mid-1900s. EDR reported that Sanborn map coverage in the area of the subject property was available for 1895, 1901, 1909, 1915, 1926, 1947 and 1956.

The 1895 and 1901 maps depict the subject property occupied by a grocery and stables. The 1909 and 1915 maps depict the stables replaced with a feed warehouse. The 1926 through 1956 maps depict the subject property redeveloped with a storefront and storage buildings. The Sanborn map review did not indicate the presence of RECs at the subject property. A copy of the Sanborn Map report is presented in **Appendix E**.

#### 4.5 Historical Use Information on Adjoining Properties

#### 4.5.1 Occupancy History

Originally a list of residents, city directories provide the name of resident or business and the type of business (if unclear) in a business index, a resident index and a street index. Available city directories, dating from 1963 to 2014, were reviewed in approximately five-year increments by Environmental Data Resources (EDR) for the adjoining properties. Historical occupants in the vicinity of the subject property included a bar & grill, taverns, a gas station, retail stores, offices and residential properties. Based on the historical use, the distance between the sites and the subject property and/or the lack of a reported release or closed release, the city directory review did not indicate the presence of RECs on the adjoining properties. A copy of the City Directory report is included in **Appendix C**.

#### 4.5.2 Aerial Photographs

Sigma reviewed aerial photographs for the adjoining properties. Available photographs, obtained from EDR, were dated 1937, 1940, 1950, 1955, 1963, 1969, 1971, 1979, 1980, 1986, 1992, 2006, 2010, 2013 and 2017. Based on the scale and general nature of the historical photographs, only major development or construction projects could be confirmed.

In general, properties in the area of the subject property were developed prior to 1937. The properties in the area of the subject property appear to be a mix of residential properties and commercial buildings. No significant change in use is depicted to the adjoining properties in the series of photographs. Specific RECs were not identified on the adjoining properties during the aerial photograph review. Copies of the photographs are included in **Appendix D**.

#### 4.5.3 Fire Insurance Maps

Sigma contacted EDR for available Sanborn Fire Insurance maps depicting the adjoining properties. Developed in the late 1800's, the maps were used until approximately the mid-1900s. EDR reported that Sanborn map coverage in the area of the subject property was available for 1895, 1901, 1909, 1915, 1926, 1947 and 1956.

A review of the Sanborn maps indicated that the subject property was historically adjoined by Main Street then storefronts, a filling station and dwellings to the northeast, a storefront and a dwelling to the southeast and College Avenue then storefronts and dwellings to the west. Based on the historical use, the distance between the sites and the subject property and/or the lack of a reported release or closed release, the Sanborn map review did not indicate the presence of RECs on the adjoining properties. A copy of the Sanborn Map report is presented in **Appendix E**.

#### 5.0 SITE RECONNAISSANCE

#### 5.1 Methodology and Limiting Conditions

On August 22, 2019, Sigma conducted a limited inspection of the subject property to examine the site for visual signs of contamination. Observations of the subject property were made of readily accessible and visually apparent areas. The interior of the convenience store and shed were inaccessible and not inspected. Where observations were limited, Sigma renders no opinion as to the presence of hazardous substances, wastes or contamination potential. Conditions at the time of the visit included sunny skies with temperatures in the 70s (°F).

The subject property was improved with a 442 square-foot convenience store with attached cooler constructed in 1960 and an approximate 96 square-foot shed. At the time of this assessment, the subject property was unoccupied. The subject property was most recently occupied by a gasoline station. Photographs of the subject property are included in **Appendix F**.

#### 5.2 Observations

5.2.1 Hazardous Substances and Petroleum Products in Connection with Identified Uses Not observed.

#### 5.2.2 Storage Tanks and Drums

All USTs were historically removed from the property (discussed in section 4.1.9). Gravel fill was observed from the most recent UST removals. Evidence of current ASTs or USTs was not observed.

Additionally, abandoned boreholes from historical site investigation activities were observed on the property.

- 5.2.3 Odors, Pools of Liquids, Stained Soil or Pavement, Stressed Vegetation Not observed.
- 5.2.4 Hazardous Substances and Petroleum Products Not Necessarily Used in Connection with Identified Uses

  Not observed.

## 5.2.5 Unidentified Substance Containers Not observed.

#### 5.2.6 Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)

Not observed.

#### 5.2.7 Wastewater Pits, Ponds or Lagoons

Not observed.

#### 5.2.8 Wastewater

Wastewater is discharged to the municipal sewer system. Industrial wastewater is not generated at the site.

#### 5.2.9 Solid Waste

With the exception of wind-blown and general refuse, waste was not observed.

#### 5.2.10 Heating

The building was heated with the use of natural gas.

#### 5.2.11 Emergency Generators

Not observed.

#### 5.2.12 Interior Stains or Corrosion

Not observed.

#### 5.2.13 Drains or Sumps

Not observed.

Additionally, from within the boundaries of the subject property, Sigma examined the adjoining properties for conditions that might indicate recognizable environmental conditions (RECs). RECs were not identified on the adjoining properties.

#### 6.0 INTERVIEWS

#### 6.1 Interviews with Site Owners

See Section 3.5 of this report.

#### 6.2 Interviews with Local Government Officials

#### 6.2.1 City of Watertown Assessors Department

Associated Appraisal is the assessor for the City of Watertown. Representatives from Associated Appraisal with intimate historical knowledge of the subject property were not identified. In lieu of interviews, Sigma reviewed available assessor records for the subject property at the Associated Appraisal website. A review of assessor records indicated that the subject property is improved with a 442 square-foot convenience store constructed in 1960. Records of environmental significance were not found.

#### 6.2.2 City of Watertown Building Inspection Department

Representatives from the City of Watertown building inspection department with intimate historical knowledge of the subject property were not identified. In lieu of interviews, on August 22, 2019 Sigma reviewed available building inspection records for the subject property at the Watertown City Hall. Records of environmental significance included numerous permits indicating that the subject property was historically occupied by a gas station, with the earliest filling station permit dated April 1, 1963.

#### 7.0 FINDINGS

The subject property, an approximate O.19-acre parcel, is located at 905 East Main Street in the City of Watertown, Jefferson County, Wisconsin. At the time of this assessment, the subject property was improved with a 442 square-foot convenience store with attached cooler reportedly constructed in 1960 and an approximate 96 square-foot shed. Historically, the subject property was developed since at least 1895. Historical occupants between 1895 and 1963 included a grocery, stables, a feed warehouse and a storefront with storage buildings. Since 1963, the subject property has been occupied by a gasoline station. The last gasoline underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed from the subject property in 2018. At the time of this assessment, the subject property was unoccupied.

A search of available environmental records was conducted by Environmental Data Resources Inc. (EDR). EDR identified the subject property in the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Solid & Hazardous Waste Information Management System (SHWIMS), Enforcement and Compliance History Information (ECHO), Facility Index System (FINDS), Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST), Recovered Government Archive (RGA)-LUST, Historical Auto Station, Underground Storage Tank (UST), Tier 2 Facility Listings (Tier 2) and Asbestos databases researched by EDR.

The subject property was identified in the RCRA, SHWIMS, ECHO and FINDS databases as a RCRA non-generator. Non-generators do not presently generate hazardous waste. The subject property was historically a generator of ignitable waste. No violations were on file for the property.

The subject property was identified in the LUST and RGA-LUST databases with two separate LUST cases. The WDNR file for the subject property was reviewed.

BRRTS #03-28-542497 Closed LUST – Marathon Gas Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Based on documentation in the WDNR file for the closed LUST #03-28-542497, a gasoline filling station had operated at the site since 1963. A 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline underground storage tank (UST) and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST were removed on May 1, 1987. Three unleaded gasoline USTs (6,000-gallon, 8,000-gallon and 10,000-gallon) were installed as replacements in May 1987.

A release associated with the USTs was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Phase II activities completed at the site in February 2005 consisted of the advancement of five soil borings and collection and submittal of soil samples for laboratory analysis. The extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater at the site were subsequently defined to meet WDNR requirements through the completion of nine additional soil borings and six

groundwater monitoring wells. Select soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis and one to two rounds of groundwater samples were collected and submitted for laboratory analysis.

Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce in a letter dated May 9, 2006.

BRRTS #03-28-583075 - Open LUST - Former Marathon Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Remaining unleaded gasoline USTs (two 8,000-gallon and one 12,000-gallon), associated piping and three associated dispensers were removed from the site in September 2018. A review of analytical results from the soil samples collected during the tank removal site assessment, identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath the former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the UST excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019 and a new BRRTS number assigned to the site. The LUST case remains open.

The subject property was identified in the Historical Auto Station and UST databases as a registered UST site with a 6,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST, an 8,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST and a 10,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on September 19, 2018 and a 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline UST and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST closed/removed on May 1, 1987. The UST removals led to the LUST cases discussed above.

The subject property was identified in the Tier 2 database with reportable quantities of gasoline historically located at the subject property. No violations were identified for the property.

The subject property was identified in the Asbestos database with an abatement/demolition project completed on September 25, 2018. No violations were identified for the property.

In addition to the subject property, EDR identified several properties on one or more of the environmental databases researched by EDR.

#### 8.0 OPINIONS

The subject property was identified in the LUST and RGA-LUST databases with two separate LUST cases. The WDNR file for the subject property was reviewed.

BRRTS #03-28-542497 Closed LUST – Marathon Gas Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Based on documentation in the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) file for the closed LUST #03-28-542497, a gasoline filling station had operated at the site since 1963. A 6,000-gallon leaded gasoline underground storage tank (UST) and a 14,000-gallon unleaded gasoline UST were removed on May 1, 1987. Three unleaded gasoline

USTs (6,000-gallon, 8,000-gallon and 10,000-gallon) were installed as replacements in May 1987.

A release associated with the USTs was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Phase II activities completed at the site in February 2005 consisted of the advancement of five soil borings and collection and submittal of soil samples for laboratory analysis. The extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater at the site were subsequently defined to meet WDNR requirements through the completion of nine additional soil borings and six groundwater monitoring wells. Select soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis and one to two rounds of groundwater samples were collected and submitted for laboratory analysis.

Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce in a letter dated May 9, 2006. The LUST case is considered a HREC.

BRRTS #03-28-583075 - Open LUST - Former Marathon Station 905 E. Main Street, Watertown, Wisconsin

Remaining unleaded gasoline USTs (two 8,000-gallon and one 12,000-gallon), associated piping and three associated dispensers were removed from the site in September 2018. A review of analytical results from the soil samples collected during the tank removal site assessment, identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath the former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the UST excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019 and a new BRRTS number assigned to the site. The LUST case remains open. The LUST case is considered a REC.

In addition to the subject property, EDR identified several properties on one or more of the environmental databases researched by EDR. Based on the relative distance between the reported sites and the subject property and/or the reported site status, the identified sites are not expected to impact the subject property.

#### 9.0 CONCLUSIONS

Sigma has performed an environmental site assessment, in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527-13. Any exceptions to, or deletions from, this practice are described in Section 10 of this report. This assessment has not revealed evidence of recognized environmental conditions at the subject property except for the following:

The subject property is an open Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) site (BRRTS #03-28-583075). A review of analytical results from soil samples collected during a tank removal site assessment completed in September 2018 identified petroleum impacts at concentrations greater than Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) beneath former dispensers and at the eastern wall of the underground storage tank (UST) excavation. Based on the UST assessment sample results, a release was reported to WDNR on February 5, 2019. The LUST case remains open.

Additionally, a historical REC (HREC) was identified at the subject property which includes the following:

• The subject property is also a closed LUST site (BRRTS #03-28-542497). A gasoline filling station operated at the subject property since 1963 and two USTs were removed in May 1987 (three USTs were installed as replacements, which were removed in September 2018 – discussed above). A release associated with the USTs removed in 1987 was identified during Phase II ESA activities. Based on the degree and extent of petroleum impacts to soil and groundwater identified through the completed soil and groundwater sampling, no significant risk to potential receptors was identified. Case closure was approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce (COMM) in a letter dated May 9, 2006.

Based on the no further action determination by COMM in 2006, there is no regulatory requirement to further investigate the residual contamination located at the subject property from the 1987 UST removals; however, residual impacts from the LUST case could be encountered in the event that subsurface soils are excavated in the future. Contaminated material that is discovered and removed would require appropriate management in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations.

#### 10.0 DEVIATIONS

There were no intentional deviations from or additions to standard practices identified in the ASTM standard for Phase 1 ESAs ASTM-1527-13 except as noted within this report.

#### 11.0 REFERENCES








