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X. Comments

Site is located on the shore of an island in the mouth of the Menominee River. Site was closed in 1973; unknown as to when it started.

According to an intra-department memorandum from Douglas Evens to Thomas Frangos "noncombustibles, inert deomolition materials, refrigerators, etc are being used at the slip edge and for diking to prevent escape of floating debris."

Waste was used to fill in an old slip which ran parellel and was open to the Marinette River.

The site was listed as handling garbage, trash, industrial, commercial and demolition material.

Site information and paperwork for this site is in the file for the Marinette City Incinerator (FID 438009220 License #2430).

Unable to conduct on-site visit - reviewed site from Ogden Street bridge. Site is on the north side of the island behind Waupaca Foundry - Marinette Plant. Site is in the Menominee River. There are trees growing on the cap. This is fenced to a point - the Foundry has restricted access to the property along the road, the rest of the site is surrounded by the river.

Site may want to be inspected further and possibly have initial monitoring done due to location in the river and unknown sources of waste disposed of at the time of use.




