Hi Harris,

To follow up on our discussion from July 19, 2023, a historic fill exemption request should be submitted for the black historic waste fill found throughout the River Point District. To be consistent with how the BRRTS cases are being handled, you can submit one historic fill exemption request which would cover all the City's work that is being done (construction of road infrastructure, various hotspot excavations, greenspace areas, etc.) across the River Point District.

Then the other historic fill exemption requests would need to be submitted at the same time as the remedial action plan/material management plan for private developments that will be proposed in the future by the property owner and their consultant. Each of these historic fill exemption requests would be associated with the parcel(s)/development area that would be parceled off and have their own BRRTS case established.
