Dear Mr. Smith:

On August 25, 2020, a Site Investigation Work Plan (SIWP) for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) identified as present on this site was submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on your behalf by AECOM. A review fee of \$700.00 was received on October 27, 2020. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the submitted work plan and **APPROVES** the scope of work with the following comments:

- This is a limited work plan based on performing historical research and use of existing site monitoring wells. Additional site investigation work beyond this scope of work may be needed to meet the requirements of Wis. Adm. Code ch. NR 716 to define contamination in soil, groundwater or other media.
- Evaluation of the potential presence of emerging contaminants other than PFAS is required per the August 17, 2020 *Emerging Contaminants Reminder Letter*.
- All actions must comply with the ch. NR 700 rule series, Wis. Adm. Code, and all other applicable state statutes and administrative rules.
- Per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.11(1)(2g), field investigation activities shall be initiated within 90 days of this notice to proceed and sampling results must be sent to the DNR and any property owner(s), including owners of off-site properties from which samples have been collected, within 10 days of receipt (Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.14).
