Hi Mark - thank you for contacting me. Here is the BRRTS # 02-03-586007. And please answer the following questions -

Was a tank involved in this release? No tank – bulk fertilizer building was removed, and fertilizer contaminated soil beneath the building was subsequently excavated. Some pesticide contaminated also soil also left in place beneath existing building.

Impacts? Contaminated soil (groundwater was not investigated because there is residual groundwater contamination for closed case).

Substance? Fertilizer - Total nitrogen (ammonia as N and Nitrate / Nitrite as N)

Pesticides (atrazine, EPTC, and metolachlor).

Activity 02-03-000005 closed 12/17/03. You mention, the reason for this new BRRTS number stems from 2017 activity. Does that need to be reflected? Additional soil remediation completed in 2017 will be tracked under new BRRTS number (assigned above). Case closure request will be submitted in the near future, and closure documents will then be submitted to DNR. Though this work was performed at the same site (i.e. land parcel), it is located away from those area with continuing obligations for the closed case (no post closure modification for the closed case). Contaminants for the closed case consisted of petroleum with comingled agrichemicals.

Contamination at the closed case (02-03-000005 RICE LAKE FARMERS UNION COOP-RICE LAKE) included petroleum comingled with agrichemicals. Though DATCP was involved, it was a DNR case, and it was closed by DNR. Because it was an active case at that time, DATCP did not send an RP letter for removal of agrichemical contaminated soil in 2017 following building removal at another portion of the site. I would like to have a separate BRRTS number because the excavation occurred at another part of the site, and after the DNR case was closed. The RP intends to submit a case closure request soon, and continuing obligations will be required (in addition to continuing obligations or the closed case).
