Melissa,

DNR has reviewed the Site Investigation Work Plan for the above referenced site received on December 18, 2020. Based on the review, the following DNR comments are provided:

- When available, please provide additional clarification if PFAS is/was present in the firefighting foam (FFF) sticks.
- If possible, please update future maps to identify the historic location of the FFF tank as well as where the FFF sticks have been used (in vicinity of proposed soil/well locations SB-21-05/MW-21-08).
- The DNR is currently in the rulemaking process to establish groundwater standards for PFAS related compounds. Future reports should include these proposed groundwater standards. As this is a developing issue you are encouraged to refer to the following websites for updated information related PFAS: <https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/PFAS> and <https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Groundwater/NR140.html>.
- Depending on the future soil and groundwater sampling results, additional site investigation activities may be needed to further define degree and extent.

With the above comments, this email serves as you notice to proceed with the proposed soil and groundwater sampling activities to further define degree and extent of known PFAS contamination in groundwater.
