As discussed this morning, marking the drums "Toxic Solids" would be acceptable indication of the hazards. The marking can either be with labels, or with the words clearly written on the drums with marker or paint pen. Once you have marked the drums please provide a photo(s) so I can document that has been resolved.

Regarding the generation and transportation of the drums. If you can, please provide additional information regarding:

- 1. The drums were generated between 2015 and 2020, over time as the filters needed changing. Please let me know if this is incorrect.
- 2. Dates or approximate dates the drums were moved from the Cecil Street location to Appleton, and when the drums returned back to Cecil Street.
- 3. I believe you mentioned that the drums were moved to the property on Edgewood Drive in Appleton, however I forgot to put that in my notes and want to confirm that was the location.
- 4. Ownership of the trailer. Please confirm if you are the owner of the trailer, or if another transporter was used to move the drums.
