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Hi Matt,

In our conference call in April, we discussed tabling discussion around using the possibility of using incremental sampling method (ISM) for this project since we want to establish a site-specific background concentration first. However, after we reviewed this feedback with Arcadis, they recommended that we use ISM to establish the site-specific background concentration if we conduct the off-site sampling later using the ISM approach. I explained this to you in a voicemail I left following our meeting and in that voicemail, I asked if you could get back to us on the possibility of implementing ISM to establish the site-specific background level of arsenic.

I wanted to follow-up on my voicemail. Let me know if there's anything we can do to facilitate our request for feedback. For example, we can organize a call with you and your colleagues and explain to you our approach and request feedback at that time. Alternatively, if you don't think the Department has any significant issues with ISM, we can put together a workplan for establishing background levels using ISM.
