Dear Mr. Jolliffe:

On March 22, 2021, REI Engineering Inc. notified the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (“WDNR” or “the Department”) that chlorinated volatile organic compounds had been detected at the site listed above. Based on the information that was initially submitted to the WDNR, you were sent a letter on May 27, 2021 explaining your obligations for restoring the environment at the referenced site under Wis. Stats. § 292.11.

This second letter is being sent to notify you, that based on an evaluation of all the information that is now available to the Department, you are not required to conduct an NR 716 site investigation for the site described above.

The Bureau for Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System (“BRRTS”) will now show the status of the site described above as a “no action required” site. As part of this action, we assign the site a new identification number in our tracking system. PLEASE NOTE: Using the new BRRTS identification number, (09-37-587331), you may view the information related to your site at any time (<http://dnr.wi.gov/topic/Brownfields/wrrd.html>) and use the feedback system to alert us to any errors in the data.


