Dear Tauren:

I write on behalf of Newell Operating Company (“NOC”) in response to the WDNR’s letter dated February 25, 2022 regarding reported contamination at Mirro Co. Plt 2 (Former), BRRTS No. 02-36-588656 (the “Site”).

NOC has reviewed the WDNR’s letter and is in the process of retaining an environmental consultant for the Site. NOC also has begun its search for the documents requested in your letter. As your letter notes, NOC sold the property in or around 2003. Any files from the time of NOC’s ownership are stored off-site and NOC anticipates it will take several weeks to obtain access to those files, particularly given that many of its employees are working remotely. Accordingly, NOC requests a 30-day extension of time, to and including April 26, 2022, to respond to the WDNR’s document request. Once NOC has located the files, it will review them and produce responsive information – if any – expeditiously.
