Good afternoon Tauren,

We wanted to inform the WDNR that four of the five residences have been scheduled for the WDNR requested second round of potable well sampling. Four of the residences are scheduled to be sampled on November 21st. We are still coordinating with the homeowner to schedule sampling at the fifth residence, 3202 Mirro Drive.

Consistent with our previous sampling event and the *Immediate Action Work Plan*, Ramboll will distribute a WAC NR 716.14 data transmittal letter to each residence within 15 business days after receipt of the Level IV laboratory report for each potable well sampled during this second round of sampling.

Good afternoon,

The DNR has reviewed the results and has discussed the results with the Wisconsin Dept. of Health Services (DHS). From the two rounds of private well data that have been collected, there are discrepancies between results from the initial round of private well sampling and this round of private well sampling. The DNR highly recommends another round from all five of the private wells that have been sampled within the next quarter (preferably late November/early December) so results, evaluation, and decisions can be made prior to the end date of DNR's Culligan Water service to the homeowners with wells above the proposed enforcement standard (ES) on January 21, 2023. The reasoning behind the sampling of all five wells is to:

- Collect a second round from the private well at 3202 Mirro Drive that has only been sampled once.
- To determine if well sampling results will continue to be below the Cycle 10 and/or 11 DHS proposed preventive action limit (PAL) and ES. The initial round had proposed PAL exceedances in two wells and proposed ES exceedances in two wells.
- To determine if there is seasonality or other factors affecting the private well results. Late November/early December sampling would be similar to the timeframe the initial round was collected (December 2021).

Since the results this round were consistent between the two labs used, you can just use one lab moving forward.

Hello Tauren,

Attached are copies of the data transmittal letters being provided to the property owners at 2519 Woodland Drive, 2722 Woodland Drive, 3104 Woodland Drive, and 3202 Mirro Drive for the July and August 2022 potable well sampling activities completed as part of the Immediate Action Work Plan for the former Mirro Plant No. 2 project (BRRTS #02-36-588656). We received the Level IV analytical reports from the second laboratory for each of these properties on September 13, 2022. The property owner names have been redacted for privacy purposes. No compounds were detected above the WDHS recommended criteria for select PFAS listed in Cycle 10 and 11 of Groundwater Standards Proposals.

In addition, we received the analytical results for the potable well sample collected at 1750 Mirro Drive from one laboratory and no PFAS compounds were detected. We are awaiting the analytical results from the second laboratory but currently anticipate receipt of the analytical report today or Monday.
