Is any new or additional information available from planned site investigation activities for August and September of this year?

I am also interested in if there are any plans to test OutfallSite#6 or the unnamed creek adjacent to the St. Francis Cemetery currently?

Additionally, please note that at least from the scoping statement, the information available appears to support testing at Outfall Site #6. There appears to be a lack of evidence beyond personnel statements about annual events that happened from the early 1990's until 2014 that indicated annual testing may not have occurred for Tanks 30 through 45 and that there appears to be no affirmative statement or additional information that the "small fire event" in 2012 near the 'north portion' of the terminal did not occur within the northeast area of the terminal reflecting tanks 30-45.
