I left a message on your cell on Friday. I do not have an e-mail address for Chris Piotrowski, please forward this e-mail to him and provide me with his e-mail address for future correspondence.

The Peer Review Group (PRG) met on Thursday April 7 to discuss the Phase II ESA for the Stetsonville Oil Clark. The PRG determined that an assessment of the contamination found during the Phase II ESA would need to be performed to determine whether the contamination is from an old release or a new release. As you know, the site was closed with continuing obligations in 2012 (03-61-000357).

- Please supply a figure(s) and narrative that supports whether the contamination identified during the Phase II ESA is residual contamination from the previous USTs, or new impacts associated with the current USTs. You may wish to superimpose the Phase II ESA borings with the borings advanced as part of the previous investigation.

Please provide the assessment by Friday April 22, 2022. I understand there is a pending real estate transaction, so I will make sure the once the revised documents are received, the DNR will perform a review as soon as possible.
