On February 28, 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the request for No Further Action Letter (Immediate Actions) – NR708.09, for the WE Energies P4 – USTs SE Corner site with the applicable fee. The DNR has reviewed the document and concurs that the environment has been restored to the extent practicable as provided in ch. NR 708.09, Wis. Adm. Code. The immediate action in response to a discharge has been completed and the DNR is requiring no further action at this time. This letter applies only to the location in the southeast corner of the property where these tanks were located.

Two excavations were completed to remove the petroleum contaminated soils identified during the removal of a 10,000-gallon diesel fuel underground storage tank and a 689-gallon unleaded gasoline underground storage tank, located in the southeast corner of the property. Based upon confirmation sampling it appears that no contaminated soils above the applicable residual contaminant levels remain in the excavated areas.

Low-level contamination may remain in the soils at the base of the excavation, though they were not sampled due to the presence of water in the excavation. These soils do not require further action at this time, but this soil may require management as a solid waste if it is excavated in the future. The property owner or right-of-way holder at the time of excavation must determine whether the material is considered solid or hazardous waste and ensure that any storage, treatment or disposal is in compliance with applicable standards and rules. Contaminated soil may be managed in accordance with ch. NR 718, Wis. Adm. Code, with prior DNR approval.
