Dear Mr. Heinze:

On February 17, 2022, Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. (a transporter) released approximately 100 gallons of non-hazardous used hydraulic oil at the Skana Aluminum facility at 2009 Mirro Drive, Manitowoc, Wisconsin. This release occurred from the storage tank of the Safety-Kleen truck when parked on the Skana Aluminum property as the used oil was being pumped into the truck during the waste service.

Upon discovery, the Safety-Kleen employee began immediate containment and cleanup of this release. The response conducted was the placement of absorbent sheets, absorbent socks, and granular material to contain and absorb the release.

Notification of this release was made via telephone to the Wisconsin Spills Emergency Hotline by Safety-Kleen's Transportation Compliance Manager, Demetrius Fisher, at approximately 3 PM on February 17, 2022. This correspondence is being provided as required per NR 708.05(6).

Also on February 17, 2022, Clean Harbors Field Services dispatched a team of employees to complete recovery and cleanup of the spilled material.

- Additional absorbent pads, socks/booms and granular material were used to absorb and collect the spilled material.
- All of the used oil was contained on an impervious surface. At no time was there a threat to human health or the environment.
- The absorbent materials were collected and placed into drums for disposal. A total of eight 55-gallon drums and one 30-gallon drum were filled with this material.
- All materials were shipped to Spring Grove Resource Recovery, Inc. in Cincinnati, OH (OHD000816629) which is owned by Clean Harbors.
