Dear Ms. Krueger:

Purpose

The Department of Natural Resources ("the department") recently reviewed your request for an off-site exemption letter for the property located at 1233 S. Commercial Street in Neenah Wisconsin, which will be referred to in this letter as "the Property." Refer to the two attached figures for maps of the Property in relation to surrounding properties. The department received a \$700 fee for providing this letter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §\$ 292.13 (2) and (3), and Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 749.

Summary Determination

The department, based on the information made available to it, confirms that PSAM, LLC qualifies for the off-site liability exemption, and PSAM, LLC is not responsible for investigation or cleanup of the contamination that originated on a neighboring property. The Property owner may be responsible for limited actions that are described in this letter, under Wis. Stat. §§ 292.12 and 292.13, for the groundwater contamination that migrated onto the Property.

Request

You have requested that the department determine if PSAM, LLC is exempt from Wis. Stats. §§ 292.11(3), (4) and (7)(b) and (c), (commonly known as the "Spill Law"), with respect to the existence of a hazardous substance discharge in the groundwater, that you believe is migrating onto the Property from an off-site source.

Wis. Stats. § 292.13(2) requires the department to issue, upon request, a written determination regarding a liability exemption for a person who possesses or controls property that is contaminated by an off-site discharge when certain conditions are met. To make this determination, the department reviewed information about the Property, including groundwater sampling data for the Property and/or other sites contained in the following documents:

- Off-Site Liability Exemption and Liability Clarification Application form (Form 4400-201) received May 3, 2023;
- Case closure documentation from Shilobrits Cleaners (02-71-228433) and Phillips 66 (03-71-002008)

Background

The department considered the documents listed above in making the determinations presented in this letter. The Property is an approximately 167' by 88' commercial lot in the City of Neenah. A commercial building is located on the eastern portion of the lot and the remainder consists of paved parking and green space. Groundwater



contamination was identified on the Property during site investigation activities for the Shilobrits Cleaners (02-71-228433) and Phillips 66 (03-71-002008) sites. Cleanup actions were conducted at each of these sites and the department determined that the cleanup was sufficient and case closure letters were issued by the department. As part of the standard case closure process, notices of residual groundwater contamination were provided to the owner of the Property. Besides the contamination in groundwater that has migrated from the two sites described above, there has been no reported release of a hazardous substance at the Property.

Determination

Based upon the available information and in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 292.13, the department makes the following determinations regarding the presence of perchloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), cis-1,2-dichloroethene, and vinyl chloride in groundwater that was detected at monitoring well locations P4, CPZ1 and CMW5 and benzene in groundwater that was detected at MW-5 and PZ1. Monitoring well locations are identified in the attached figures.

The department, based on the information available, determined that the Property owner met the conditions in Wis. Stats. § 292.13 to qualify for the liability exemption, including but not limited to the following provisions:

- 1. The hazardous substance discharge originated from a source on property that is not possessed or controlled by PSAM, LLC.
- 2. PSAM, LLC did not possess or control the hazardous substance on the property on which the discharge originated.
- 3. PSAM, LLC did not cause the discharge.
- 4. PSAM, LLC will not have liability under the Spill Law for investigation or remediation of the groundwater contamination originating from off-site onto the Property, provided that PSAM, LLC does not take possession or control of the property on which the discharge originated.

Exemption Conditions

The department's determination, as set forth in this letter, is subject to compliance with the following conditions, as specified in Wis. Stats. §§ 292.13(1) and (1m).

- 1. The facts upon which the department based its determination are accurate and do not change.
- 2. PSAM, LLC agrees to allow the following parties to enter the Property to take action to respond to the discharge: the department and its authorized representatives; any party that possessed or controlled the hazardous substance or caused the discharge; and any consultant or contractor of such a party.
- 3. PSAM, LLC agrees to avoid any interference with action undertaken to respond to the discharge and to avoid actions that worsen the discharge.
- 4. PSAM, LLC agrees to any other condition that the department determines is reasonable and necessary to ensure that the department and any other authorized party can adequately respond to the discharge.

Responsibilities for Continuing Obligations

In addition to the conditions above, the following continuing obligation was applied to Property as part of the case closure for the two source properties.

Residual Groundwater Contamination (Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 140 and § NR 812.09(4)(w)) Groundwater contamination which equals or exceeds the enforcement standards for PCE, TCE, cis-1,2-dichloroethane, and vinyl chloride in groundwater at monitoring well locations P4, CPZ1 and CMW5 and benzene in groundwater at MW-5 and PZ1 was detected on the Property. To construct a new well or reconstruct

an existing well, the property owner must obtain prior DNR approval. Additional casing may be necessary to prevent contamination of the well.

Additional Environmental Considerations

Contaminated groundwater is present on the Property in the above-described sample locations, which are shown on the attached maps. Owners and occupants of the Property should be aware that construction over the contaminated groundwater may in some conditions result in vapor migration of contaminants into enclosed structures or migration along newly placed underground utility lines. The potential for vapor inhalation and means of mitigation should be evaluated when planning any future redevelopment, and measures should be taken to ensure the continued protection of public health, safety, welfare, and the environment at the Property.

General Wastewater Permits for Construction-related Dewatering Activities (Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 200)
The DNR's Water Quality Program regulates point source discharges of contaminated water, including discharges to surface waters, storm sewers, pits, or to the ground surface. This includes discharges from construction-related dewatering activities, including utility work and building construction.

If the property owner or any other person plans to conduct such activities, that person must contact the Water Quality Program and, if necessary, apply for the required discharge permit. If residual soil or groundwater contamination is likely to affect water collected in a pit/trench that requires dewatering, a general permit for discharge of *Contaminated Groundwater from Remedial Action Operations* may be needed. If water collecting in a pit/trench that requires dewatering is expected to be free of pollutants other than suspended solids, oil and grease, a general permit for pit/trench *Dewatering Operations* may be needed. Additional information can be obtained by visiting the DNR website at "dnr.wi.gov," search "wastewater general permits."

Conclusion

The department granted PSAM, LLC an off-site exemption under Wis. Stats. § 292.13. Please note that the department may revoke the determinations made in this letter if it determines that any of the requirements under Wis. Stats. § 292.13, cease to be met.

Future Property owners are eligible for the exemption under Wis. Stats. § 292.13, if they meet the requirements listed in that statute section. The determinations in this letter regarding a liability exemption, however, only apply to PSAM, LLC, and may not be transferred or assigned to other parties. The department will provide a written determination to future owners of this Property, if such a determination is requested in accordance with the requirements of Wis. Stats. § 292.13.




