





In order to meet OSHA and NFPA life-safety requirements, we conducted several of our Fire Suppression system PMs last week. Due to the fact that we have known PFAS in our Fire Suppression water loop, we hired an external contractor, Clean Harbors, to assist us and collect all of the water generated for disposal via incineration.

During that activity, one of the vac-tanker drivers from a sub-contracted transportation provider placed an uncapped hose onto a tarp at approximately 10:30AM on Wednesday, June 24th while making the connections between hydrant tests. The residual water in the hose ran onto a containment tarp and then a small amount of the water escaped the tarp. As stated in the call to the spill reporting line, approximately 1 cup of fire suppression water with a potential concentration up to 6400 ug/L (6.4 ppt) PFOS was released to our gravel parking area. An immediate response was initiated- the spill was contained and all contaminated materials were excavated and disposed of. Approximately 2 cubic feet of gravel was excavated and drummed for incineration with the other project materials such as used PPE or spill pads.






